## City of Milwaukee Priorities for Budget Repair

- Shared Revenue increase (or maintain) the Shared Revenue appropriation
- School Choice Property Tax Relief maintain the poverty aid program
- Summer Youth Jobs Program maintain \$500,000 per year support
- Community Policing Grants maintain \$250,000 per year to support targeted policing
- <u>Tipping Fees</u> no further increase in fees, unless offset by additional grants
- Levy Limits no further restrictions
- General Transportation Aid maintain the 2% increase
- <u>Lift Bridge Aids</u> maintain 100% offset of operating and maintenance
- Mass Transit Aid maintain increase to MCTS and other systems
- KRM Commuter Rail provide a dedicated source of funding for mass transit before approving a rental car fee
- <u>Library Aids</u> maintain the increased Library System Aid and Library Service Contract funding
- School of Public Health maintain \$200,000 to study the UWM School of Public Health
- MPS Math Initiative maintain funding for educational disparities
- Support funding for other Milwaukee Initiatives, including funding for Milwaukee County and Milwaukee Public Schools.

## **Proposed Fiscal Policy Initiatives:**

- Housing Trust Fund add SB 426, the TIF funding proposal
- Foreclosure Prevention Initiatives add provisions to address foreclosure crisis
- Wireless 911 Cell Phone Surcharge shift the surcharge to municipalities for emergency services
- <u>Income Assignment</u> add provision that allows a municipal court to issue an order assigning income for payment of municipal debts.
- <u>Parking Scofflaws</u> add provision that would allow cities to adopt an ordinance that provides for the immobilization and impoundment of vehicles owned by habitual parking violators.
