RE: SWORN FIRE AND SWORN POLICE MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES RETIREE HEALTH INSURANCE

Dear Gentlemen:

On July 15, 2003 the Common Council approved resolution 030405 regarding retiree health insurance benefits for sworn fire and sworn police management employees hired or promoted after January 1, 2004 that requires them to pay as retirees the same as active employees. This change does not allow them to use sick leave as an incentive to control their share of retiree health care costs along the lines that Local 215, Milwaukee Police Association (MPA) and Milwaukee Police Supervisors Organization (MPSO) labor contracts provide. The Employee Benefits and Budget office have found the two retiree health systems are cost neutral and do not diminish or enhance the retiree benefit.

There is a desire to change the retiree health insurance system for sworn fire and sworn police management employees hired after January 1, 2004 so this group will be provided with an incentive to save their sick leave so it can be used to help control their share of retiree health care costs along the lines that are currently done with Local 215, MPA and MPSO labor contracts.
