SUMMARY OF 2008 CRASH DATA

- Reportable Crashes were decreased by 596 or (12,274) compared to (12,870) in 2007. This is a 5% reduction.
- The number of Related Injuries was decreased by 490 or (3,641) compared to (4,131) in 2007. This is a 12% reduction.
- Major changes in types of crashes:
 - * Alcohol, 54 or (523) compared to (577) in 2007. A reduction of 10%.
 - * Failure to Yield, 609 or (2,584) compared to (3,193) in 2007. A reduction of 24%.
 - * Disregard of Signal, 436 or (1,197) compared to (1,633) in 2007. A reduction of 36%.
- Traffic Citations were increased by 37,321 or (90,011) compared to (127,332) in 2007. *A 29% increase*.
- There was an increase in Seat Belt Citations up 6,022 or (10,224) compared to (4,202) in 2007. A 59% increase.
- An analysis of the 2008 Fatal Traffic Summary compared to 2007 shows an increase in the number of Fatal Crashes in the following Aldermanic Districts: #1, #2, #6, #8, #11 and #15.
- The most significant changes in Traffic Fatalities occurred in: District #3 Alderman Kovac, decreased from three (3) to zero (0) District #7 Alderman Wade, decreased from six (6) to one (1). District #9 Alderman Puente, decreased from two (2) to zero (0). District #13 Alderman Witkowski, decreased from three (3) to zero (0). District #14 Alderman Zielinski, decreased from three (3) to one (1).

A breakdown shows that Speeding & Failure to Have Control are the dominant fatal crash causes. The use of alcohol continues to impact on the number of fatal crashes. During 2008, there were 14 alcohol related fatal crashes out of 31 that were over the .08 alcohol level. Of those 14 fatals, nine were motor vehicle, four were pedestrian and one was motorcycle.

Seat belt usage in the 18 motor vehicle fatals showed one was buckled, 14 were unbuckled and three were unknown.
