

Various Legislative Priorities for the Governor-Elect

- 1) Balance state budget. (- \$2.7 billion over biennium)
- 2) Cut corporate tax. (Reduce GPR - \$834 million annually)
- 3) Reduce top individual income tax rate. (Reduce GPR)
- 4) Other tax cuts:
 - Repeal Combined Reporting.
 - Restore the 60% tax exemption for capital gains.
 - Phase out tax on retirement income.
 - Exempt Health Savings Accounts.
- 5) Create 250,000 jobs and 10,000 new businesses by 2015.
- 6) Stop the high speed rail line between Madison and Milwaukee.
- 7) Shift portion of sales tax to Transportation Fund. (Reduce GPR/Increase SEG)
- 8) Seek Constitutional Amendment prohibiting transfers from the Segregated Transportation Fund.
- 9) Repeal hospital assessment. (Reduce State revenue and revenues for local hospitals)
- 10) Roll back eligibility for BadgerCare recipients. (Decrease costs)
- 11) Repeal the statewide smoking ban.
- 12) Repeal residency requirement for teachers.
- 13) Lift enrollment caps on the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program and the 2r Charters.
- 14) Fund MPCP and charter schools at 80% of MPS per pupil payment. (Reduce State GPR and equalization aids to Milwaukee)
- 15) Restore the Qualified Economic Offer for school districts.
- 16) Allow School districts/local governments to enroll in the State employee Health Plan.
- 17) Require state employees to contribute to health and pension. (Decrease Costs)
- 18) Seek Constitutional Amendment to require voters to show identification at the polls.
- 19) Legalize Concealed Carry and pass Castle Doctrine Law.
- 20) Roll back the Early Release Program.
