Our new goal was to preserve as much of the existing play space as possible, along with parking for the church and school. After reviewing the most recent site plan and Maures' letter of intent, we are satisfied with what is being proposed related to the land set aside for St. Lucas.

We're thankful to MPS for instructing the developer to meet the play space and parking needs of our church and school in their Request for Proposals. We greatly appreciate Maures Development's willingness to listen and work with us.

We're also truly grateful to Alderman Zielinski and Mayor Barrett for their willingness to protect play space and parking for St. Lucas.
