## RE: City of Milwaukee Participation in Rooftop Solar Challenge II Award DE-FOA-0000788

Dear Ms. Heart,

As you are aware, the MREA and City of Milwaukee had worked collaboratively on a proposal in response to US Dept. of Energy Funding Opportunity Announcement DE-FOA-0000788 – Rooftop Solar Challenge II. On May 16 of this year we were brought into negotiation with DOE leading to award. I have attached the engagement letter for your reference.

Though the total funding allocated for the award has been reduced, we are moving forward with negotiations and expect a final contract with DOE by July 15. The project is composed of 2 budget periods with Period 1 lasting 18 months and Period 2 lasting 12 months. Funding for period 2 will need to be secured through a continuation approval based on our performance in Budget Period 1. The scope and objectives of the project are described in the attached document 0788-1507\_MREA\_Final SOPO.pdf.

As part of this contract, we have budgeted \$96,200 to contract with the City of MKE to dedicate a .5 FTE staff effort to support this work. In addition we have included \$15,000 of in-kind support from the City as described in the attached letter of commitment dated May 30, 2014. I have highlighted the task areas in 0788-1507\_MREA\_Final SOPO.pdf that describe how the City's efforts will be dedicated. Once the award is finalized with DOE, I will work with you to develop a scope of work specific for the City of Milwaukee.
