(1) In accordance with the provisions of Section 295-907 of the Code relating to the establishment of planned development districts, the Common Council approves the subject Detailed Planned Development, a copy of which is attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully Clerk and made o port as though fully set forth herein.

(2) The zoning map is amended to (2) The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for the areo described and bounded by 522 East Pleasant Street, Tax Key No. 360-0064-000, and 1601 North Jackson Street, Tox Key No. 360-0063-100, from Local Business (LB2) to Detailed Planned Development IDPD)

(3) The requirements set forth in soid detailed plan attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A, constitute the zoning regulations for the area contained in such planned development district described, provided further, that the effect of the approval of such detailed plan is that such plan shall limit and control construction, location, use and operation of all land and structures included within the detailed plan to all conditions and limitations set forth in such detailed plan.
