## **Dear Council Members:**

Enclosed is a proposed resolution and fiscal note authorizing payment of a settlement amount regarding the indemnification cross claims raised by several codefendants in the above-referenced matter. We request that the enclosed documents also be referred to the appropriate committee or committees for review.

This case stems from an event which occurred on October 24, 2004, and which involved plaintiff Frank L. Jude, Jr. and several individuals who were then employed as Milwaukee police officers. Mr. Jude claimed that those individuals used excessive force against him while acting in the scope of their employment. The City defended that those individuals did not commit the subject acts while acting in the scope of their employment, but rather that they acted to further their own personal interests, which were unrelated to their official duties. Mr. Jude's claims were settled earlier this year for \$2,000,000.00.

While Mr. Jude's claims have been settled, the codefendants' cross claims for indemnification remain viable. We recently negotiated a settlement amount during mediation. The total amount negotiated

was \$194,500.00. We recommend that these matters be settled for that amount. Consistent with our recommendation, we have enclosed an appropriate resolution for your consideration.
