I was scheduled to appear in front of the Public Safety Committee on 12/5/2013. I did not attend. My daughter had moved out of the house and when she changed her address, all of the mail from everyone in the house was being sent to her new address so I didn't get the letter until after that date.

You have all my driving records, suspensions, e.t.c information. Last year my permit was suspended for 10 days which then became 20 days. When I went to renew my Public Passenger License again it was suspended again for 10 days which again became 20 days.

I have been working with the court system and was put on an installment plan. If I missed a payment or wasn't on time they would suspend my license.
