1. Review and Approval of the Minutes of the December 12, 2007 Meeting

Mr. Gurda moved for approval of the minutes. There were no objections.

2. Relationship Between This Body and Other Bodies That Honor Mr. Zeidler

Mr. Heitzer said that the Public Enterprise Committee is the main group that has an annual event with a lecture and the Turners is considering having a lecture. There are also other organizations in the community that are trying to memorialize Mr. Zeidler. The Interfaith Conference of Greater Milwaukee also presents an annual award related to Mr. Zeidler and his work.

3. Review and Approval of the Award Format

Mr. Arnold provided two samples of the obelisks as well as a print-out of the text and medallion which would be on the obelisk. The supplier could etch on the bottom of the award, but could not affix a coin to the bottom. The etching could also be filled with a gold leaf to highlight the text. The supplier could produce the obelisks in a matter of days.

Mr. Heitzer moved that the obelisk be decorated on the front with the City Hall etching and the city seal etched on the bottom. Mr. Pratt and Mr. Gurda supported having the City Hall etching on the front and were amenable to having the seal etched on the bottom. Mr. Arnold will research whether the obelisks can be procured from a union, American provider.

4. Status of the Nomination Form Related to Distribution and Public Reaction

Only one individual contacted the staff assistant about making a nomination and that was on behalf of his minor child. Seth Foldy, a former Commissioner of Health for the City of Milwaukee, contacted the staff assistant about having a public health award presented at the same meeting as the Zeidler award will be presented. The Committee was not supportive of this and the staff assistant will contact Mr. Foldy about the Committee's decision.
