We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant, Shurone Nash, 3370 North 84th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53222 alleges that on June 7-8, 2008 she sustained damages when a City sewer backed up into her basement. The Office of Assessor information notes that she is not the owner of record for this property. She claims damages in the amount of \$7,243.00.

Our investigation reveals that the Infrastructure Services Division records indicate that because of the large amount and intensity of the rain during this weekend, the City experienced flows that exceeded the capacity of the sewer systems. The City was not negligent in this matter as such; the City would not be liable. Therefore, we recommend that this claim be denied.
