The Department of City Development reports that the tax foreclosed property located at 3833 West Hemlock Street, Tax Key No. 102-0122-000-4, is not suitable for use by a public agency or community based organization. However, said property is located in the Northwest Side planning area. DCD is concerned that if the property is returned to the lender, disposition may not be to an owner occupant and could adversely affect neighborhood stability due to the large number of foreclosed homes to be sold.

This residential structure is occupied; no rent has been collected. Administrative costs incurred by our Department total \$538.33.
