City is required to open for commercial boats rated for 50 or more passengers per Title 33 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Subchapter J, § 117.1093, paragraph a.

The draws of each bridge listed in this section shall open as soon as
possible for the passage of public vessels of the United States, vessels
carrying United States mail, vessels licensed to carry 50 or more
passengers when on their regular routes, and fireboats of the City of
Milwaukee.



The draws of all bridges across the Milwaukee River shall open on signal if at least two hours notice is given; except that, from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., the draws need not be opened.

 The exceptions are Broadway, Water and Michigan do not require a two hour notice

What has been done in 2017 to Improve Operations:

- Bells:
 - o Bells no longer ring throughout bridge opening.
 - o Bells turn off after traffic gates are down.
- Limiting openings:
 - o Bridge Operators instructed to give traffic either five minutes or three green light cycles to allow traffic to clear before performing another bridge opening.
 - o Stage openings to let several boats through at one opening.
 - Take into account vehicular and pedestrian traffic prior to bridge opening.



What we are doing for 2018:

•Wisconsin Avenue Bridge:

- Changing controls to allow two gates to be operated simultaneously (currently they can only be operated one at a time). Anticipated time savings of 45 seconds.
- Modifying the hydraulics and pump speed to reduce total operating time by 40 seconds.
- Wells Street Bridge is under rehabilitation.
 - Hydraulic and electrical improvements will allow faster opening times.



What we are doing for 2018:

- •Inform commercial and recreational boat owners (passengers < 50) no bridge openings between 4:30 p.m. 5:30 p.m. per regulations.
- •Work with commercial boat owners (passengers ≥ 50) to avoid bridge openings between 4:30 p.m. 5:30 p.m.
 - Generally have been accommodating but changes to schedules may be required.
- •Brief bridge operators on procedures prior to boating season.
