


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

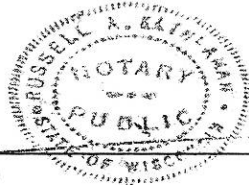

Owczarski, City Clerk of the City of Milwaukee, certify that pursuant to Section 4-06-3 of the Milwaukee City Charter, notice is given of the passage of the following ordinances by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee on 02/06/2018, with the approval of Mayor Tom Barrett. The full text of each of the ordinances listed below can be obtained at the Office of the City Clerk, Room 205, City Hall, 200 E. Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 53202.

170927 A substitute ordinance relating to the abandonment of shopping carts.

171153 A substitute ordinance relating to regulations, requirements, and procedures for various licenses and permits.

171212 A substitute ordinance relating to the change in zoning from a Detailed Planned Development, DPD, known as Clarke Square to Institutional, TL, to accommodate the redevelopment of 1818 West National Avenue into a school, located on the north side of West National Avenue, east of South 20th Street, in the 12th Aldermanic District.

171270 A substitute ordinance relating to the First Amendment to the General Planned Development, GPD, known as Freshwater Plaza to permit changes to the uses and design standards for future development on the lot identified as Phase III (Lot 4) of the GPD, located at 200 East Greenfield Avenue, on the north side of East Greenfield Avenue, east of South 1st Street, in the 12th Aldermanic District.

171287 A substitute ordinance relating to key security at car rental agencies.

171429 An ordinance establishing a pedestrian mall to be known as "Arena Connector Pedestrian Mall" in the east-west alley and a portion of the north-south alley in the block bounded by West Highland Avenue, West Juneau Avenue, North Old World Third Street and North 4th Street Pedestrian Mall, in the 4th aldermanic district.

171463 A substitute ordinance relating to parking controls.

171464 A substitute ordinance

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relating to traffic controls.

171485 A substitute ordinance to further amend the 2018 rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service.

171486 A substitute ordinance to further amend the 2018 offices and positions in the City Service.

171535 A substitute ordinance relating to the provision of pedestrian protection in connection with the construction or demolition of buildings in C9 downtown zoning districts.

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
