Property Description of work

2333 S. 6th Street

St. Josaphat Basilica

1. 4 ft and 6 ft high Decorative Aluminum fencing (approximately 238 LF) to be located at the northeast corner of W. Lincoln Avenue and S. 7th Street. This area will also include a new 6 ft H x 20 ft W sliding, manual, gate.
2. 6 ft. high black cyclone fence (approximately 330 LF) to be located at the southeast corner of the property along S. 6th Street and W. Hayes Avenue. This corner includes, one, 2 panel- 6ftHx10ftW swinging, manual, gate, at the northeast parking lot entry, two, 2 panel - 6 ft H x 8 ft W swinging, manual, gates at the south. There is also approximately 90 LF of the fence along S. 7th Street that includes one, 6 ft H x 16 ft W sliding, manual, gate.

Diagrams on the following pages show distinct placement posts, fence sections, and sizes of gates.

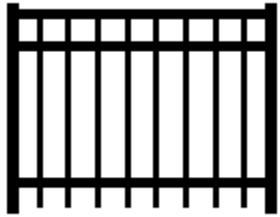

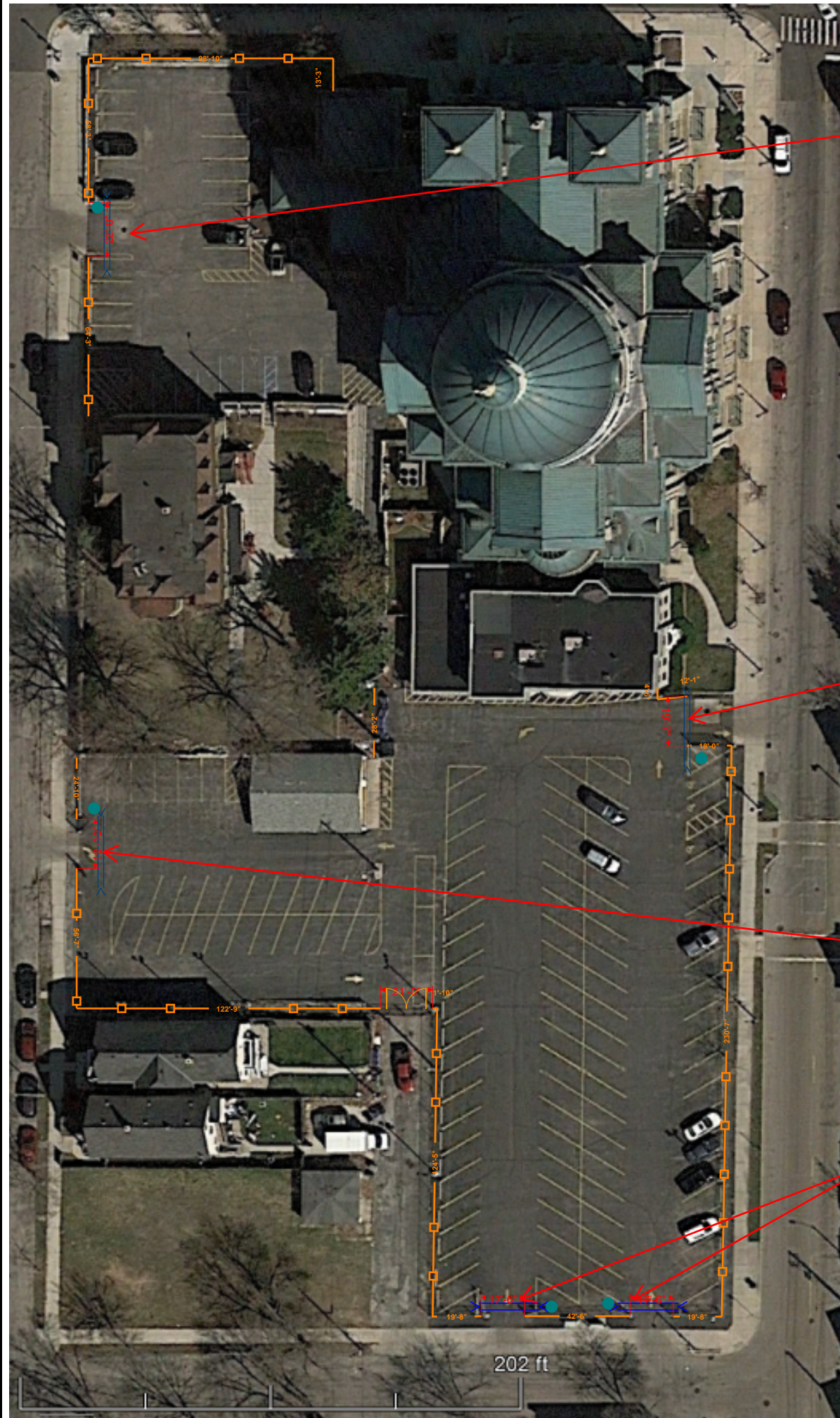

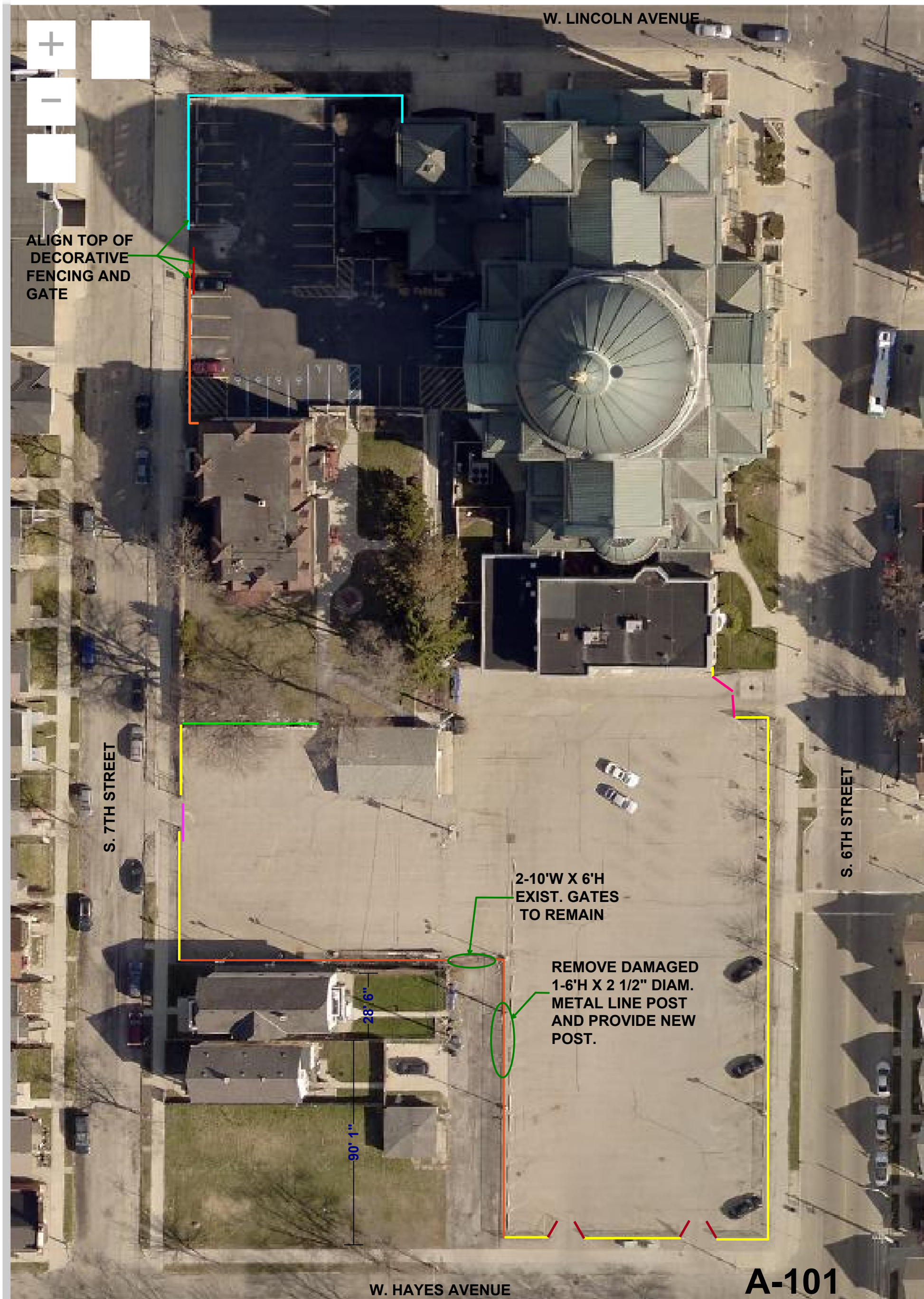
