Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 01/23/24 at 11:19p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. The agent was on scene and advised officers a fight took place inside the establishment and a subject pulled out a gun. The agent stated they search males; therefore, they think a female snuck the gun in her purse. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
2. On 02/13/24 at 9:55p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. Officers observed parking issues related to the business and asked an employee to make an announcement to have patrons legally park their cars. Officers further advised the agent the license's that were posted were not current. The agent later walked into the District to show the current licenses.

3. On 08/04/24 at 4:20p.m., Milwaukee Police took a walk-in Battery that occurred at approximately 12:50a.m., in front of 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. Officers were advised the victim had just left the club, when two suspects who were in the club earlier, battered her. The victim stated they didn't call the police at the time of the incident, since the suspects fled immediately after.

4. On 10/29/24 at 9:32p.m., Milwaukee Police took a walk-in Domestic Violence complaint that occurred at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. Officers were advised the victim was at the club, when the suspect entered the business and caused a disturbance, knocking the victim's food to the ground. The suspect also made a threat, when the victim comes outside, they would shoot them. Security was advised and told the victim to go to the District and file a complaint.

On 08/04/2024 at 4:20pm, while I was working as the front desk SGT, Shatoria L HARRIS (B/F 12/14/1993) came into the district to report a battery.

HARRIS stated that around 12:50 am on 08/04/2024 she went to a club that was called Savoy's Night Club. HARRIS stated that she was there for 2 hours and then the club was closing, and everybody was leaving. HARRIS stated that she was with her friend by the name of "Jennifer COLEMAN". HARRIS stated that she then walked outside and was on the sidewalk outside of the club and did not see her friend behind her. HARRIS stated that she then waited until her friend got outside. HARRIS stated that COLEMAN then walked outside and two suspect made comments towards COLEMAN and HARRIS got upset about it. HARRIS stated that suspect 1 was a Black, male, dark skinned, 508 feet ,250 pounds, wearing a black shirt and Blue Jeans. HARRIS stated that suspect 2 was a black, male, light skinned, 508 feet ,250 pounds, wearing a black shirt and Blue Jeans. HARRIS stated that she stated something to the two suspect and then they got mad at her. HARRIS stated that suspect 1 and 2 then attacked her. HARRIS stated suspect 1 and suspect 2 intentionally and without consent pulled her hair and then threw her to the ground which caused her pain and injury. HARRIS stated that both of the suspect battered her. HARRIS stated that the suspects then left the scene after she was thrown to the ground. HARRIS stated that she did not call the police when it happened because the suspect left the scene. The incident happened on the sidewalk outside of the club. HARRIS does not know if the club has cameras on the outside of the building.

HARRIS stated that her friend was talking to suspect 2 early in the night and got his name. HARRIS then gave me the name of "Nick Smith" with the birthday date of 08/14/1992. I then checked the name thru the Milwaukee Police department database and did not get anybody that match that name. I then ran the name thru DOT, and no one came back. HARRIS stated that the name was taken off of social media.

HARRIS had some minor lacerations on her neck and her right arm and both her knees. I then took 10 photos of HARRIS injuries.

This case is pending.

On Tuesday, October 29, 2024 at approximately 9:32 PM, I spoke with Kiesha S. GIVHAN (B/F 10-24-1984), who stated on today's date at approximately 9:00 PM at the location of 2901 N Dr. William Finlayson St., Savoy's Night Club, she received threatening text messages and phone calls from her ex-boyfriend, identified as George J. REED, Jr. (B/M 06-30-1977).

Victim/Suspect Interviews:

INTERVIEW WITH GIVHAN

GIVHAN stated REED told her he knew she was at Savoy's and said, "I'm going to pay my \$10 and come in."

GIVHAN stated REED eventually came to Savoy's and created a loud disturbance, knocking her plate of chicken to the ground. GIVHAN stated REED told her when she comes outside he is going to shoot her.

GIVHAN stated she left with the security guard from Savoy's and came to District 5 to report the incident. GIVHAN stated while she was at District 5, she received a picture message from REED showing the hallway of her residence. GIVHAN stated she also received a phone call from her children, not identified, who stated REED had come into the residence and then left.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 7/22/2025 at 10:20 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
