bravery.*

WHEREAS,

LINDA LUBOTSKY

*was recognized for quick thinking and bravery which helped save a man's life on October
23, 2017; and*

***WHEREAS,** While driving not far from S. 43rd St. and W. Howard Ave., at
Willow Way, Greenfield Alderwoman Linda Lubotsky saw a man driving in a funeral
procession crash into a fire hydrant, drive onto grass, over the sidewalk, into a fence and
into a tree; and*

***WHEREAS,** Linda Lubotsky, who is also a nurse, tended to him and helped
control the bleeding and tried to keep him calm while the man had a seizure; and*

***WHEREAS,** Linda Lubotsky and other courageous strangers came to the injured
man's aid, and waited with him for 25 minutes until the paramedics took over; now,
therefore, be it*

***RESOLVED,** That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith
recognizes and commends Alderwoman Linda Lubotsky for her courage, concern and
bravery, and extends its sincere appreciation on behalf of the community, and wishes for
her continued health and happiness; and, be it*

presented to Alderwoman Linda Lubotsky, an exemplary citizen.*
