On July 10, 2007, the City Clerk's Office provided notice to Jonathan Little, Agent for Carey Limousine of Wisconsin, Inc., relating to your appeal of the denial of your luxury limousine applications. This appeal was scheduled for hearing on July 19, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 301-B of City Hall. At said date, time and place, the licensee did appear and admitted receipt of the notice and was not represented by counsel.

At that time, the Public Safety Committee recommended denial of your appeal relating to these applications to operate two Toyota Highlanders and two Toyota Prius' as Luxury limousines under the executive sedan classification, s. 100-3-11-b of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinance.

You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on July 31, 2007 commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202 to consider your application for the operation of the aforementioned vehicles in the City of Milwaukee.

You may file a written objection to the report of the Public Safety Committee and shall have the opportunity to present arguments in writing supporting that objection to the Common Council. Any written objections to the committee's report must be filed with the City Clerk no later than 4:45 p.m. on Thursday, July 26, 2007. If you file a written objection, you or a legal representative may also appear at the Common Council meeting and request an opportunity to address the Common Council for approximately five (5) minutes to present oral arguments on your own behalf.
