1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

This subcontract from CHS will support care coordination and case management for children who receive emergency department services due to the severity of their asthma. Care Coordination entails reviewing families for need, educating them about services to be provided, obtaining informed consent and referring enrolled families to a case management provider. The goal of care coordination and case management is to improve the quality of life for families impacted by asthma through assessing their needs, developing a family-centered plan of care and making appropriate referrals for services. The Health Department's Care Coordinator will also provide oversight to public and private sector case management providers to assure standardized and effective interventions for evaluation purposes.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

Pediatric asthma is a strategic priority under the Health Department's Home Environmental Health and Maternal and Child Health Divisions.

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

This subcontract will allow the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to develop the service infrastructure needed to serve families impacted by asthma. The MHD is uniquely postured to provide leadership for this function based on its knowledge of care coordination and case management of other public health problems.
