Restore and/or stabilize the historic granite facade; primarily the stone cornices, gutters, at the turrent, damaged granite corners and the balcony above the north entrance. The project also includes correction of failing gutters, repointing, sealnt repairs, and the treatment preservation of the exterior stone, th brick masonry, an the supporting steel structure for these elements. Necessary scaffolding is also approved.

Project includes "sponge-jet" micro-abrasive cleaning and chemical cleaning with Prosoco products per documents in this file and permit MBC-18-00001.
