Dear Alderman Hines:

This is in response to a request we received from your office on behalf of a local resident to install the above-captioned parking restriction.

Presently the south side of the 3500 and 3600 blocks of West Cherry Street has a "No Parking December 1<sup>st</sup> to March 1<sup>st</sup>" restriction and a "No Parking School Days 7:30 am to 4:30 pm" restriction on the north side of the street. This leaves the residents of this block with nowhere to park during the winter months on school days.

In an effort to increase available parking in the winter months for these residents, we recommend changing the "No Parking December 1<sup>st</sup> to March 1<sup>st</sup>" restriction to the north side of the street. This change would allow residents to park on the south side of the street.
