There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

7. On 08/07/15, Milwaukee police were performing underage tavern enforcement initiative and had an underage police aide attempt to enter the business at 2859 N Oakland Avenue. The aide was stopped at the door and turned away when she could not provide identification.

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8. On 03/31/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1. An underage Police Aid attempted to gain entry to Axel's, 2859 N. Oakland Av. The Police Aid was allowed entry because there was no security at the door. The Police Aid ordered and was served a Miller Lite beer for \$3.00.

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10. On 02/23/21 at 7:37pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 2859 N. Oakland Avenue. The staff was cooperative and helpful and no violations were found.

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11. On 02/25/22, officers were dispatched to 2859 N. Oakland Av., for a Sick and Injured Person. Investigation revealed two patrons who were underage were found to be in possession of fake id's and had consumed alcohol at the establishment. The agent was on scene and asked officers for suggestions to stop this from occurring again. The agent was cooperative during the investigation.

12. On 04/21/22, officers were dispatched to 2859 N. Oakland av., for a Tavern Violation. Investigation revealed there were numerous patrons under the legal drinking age in the bar. Some of which had fake id's, however, some of the patrons stated they did not have identification and were not asked by the bouncer. The agent was on scene and cooperative with the investigation and requested ID Training for his employees to avoid repeating the violations.

13. On 04/28/22, officers conducted an Underage Tavern Enforcement at 2859 N. Oakland Av., utilizing police aides. Security did request identification from the police aides, therefore, the police aides did not gain access to the establishment.

14. On 02/23/23 at 11:54p.m., officers conducted an Underage Tavern Enforcement at 2859 N. Oakland Av. Investigation revealed there were numerous patrons that appeared and admitted to being underage. Some patrons stated they walked right past the bouncer without being asked to provide identification, and others stated they were friends with the bouncer and that's how they gained entry. Multiple citations were issued to patrons for Misrepresenting Age to Receive Alcohol. An announcement was made for all individuals to leave the premise if they were underage or had a fake ID. At that time, approximately 40 individuals left the bar. The bouncer stated they scanned everyone's ID and no one was allowed without ID. The agent was on scene and very cooperative with the investigation.

15. On 03/16/23 at 8:30p.m., Milwaukee Police along with Department of Revenue Alcohol and Tobacco, conducted a License Premise Check at 2859 N. Oakland Av. Investigation

revealed there were no invoices for Alcohol on premises, however, the DOR Agent advised the agent they would allow them a few days to email the invoices. Three open bottles of alcohol were contaminated and the agent was advised to dump the alcohol and deface the bottles. Further inspection showed a dirty sticky funnel in the storage area where alcohol is stored. The DOR Agent stated this was commonly known to be used to refill alcohol bottles. The agent was on scene and advised of the violations and stated the funnel was used for cleaning. The officer was going to submit a request to the Health Department to conduct an inspection due to the observations of the bar being dirty, and the concerns of bugs in alcohol bottles.

16. On 08/29/23 at 2:31a.m, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 2859 N. Oakland Av. Investigation revealed an intoxicated patron became angry after being told they smelled of body odor, and began to smash glasses on the bar. The agent stated they had to grab the patron's arm to stop them from smashing more glasses. The patron then directed their anger toward a friend cleaning glasses behind the bar, and threw a glass at them, causing a laceration that required sutures. The patron was arrested on scene. The agent was cooperative with the investigation, however, did smell of intoxicants.

17. On 10/12/23 at 8:22p.m., officers conducted an Underage Tavern Enforcement at 2859 N. Oakland Av., utilizing police aides. Security did request identification from the police aides, therefore, the police aides did not gain access to the establishment.

18. On 03/30/24 at 1:53a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 2859 N. Oakland Ave. Prior to arrival officers were advised the establishment had approximately 50 underage patrons. On arrival officers did not observe the violation and investigation revealed the caller was a patron who was kicked out earlier due to causing a disturbance. The business was cooperative.

The following items pertain to the above listed business

19. On 09/25/24 at 2:32p.m., Milwaukee Police took a walk-in complaint at District 5 regarding the business. The victim stated on 09/24/24 at approximately 11:30p.m., they presented the owner with a fake ID, indicating they were 21. Upon entrance they were served a beer and a shot. The victim stated they took the shot and left the beer unattended, but drank it later. The victim stated they became incapacitated and had to be carried out by their friends. Further stated they sought medical attention and a urinalysis was positive for Rohypnol. Follow up was requested by District 1 personnel who stated the business was closed and they were unable to make contact with the agent or obtain video surveillance.

20. On 12/13/24 at 2:43a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject. An anonymous caller stated there were underage at the bar. Officers met with the Agent who stated they have a digital scanner and employees verifying age. Officers contacted the caller who admitted they made the call due to anger at a friend and provided the friend's information, in which the business was able to pull up the info on the scanner and provided a date of birth of 07/09/02, making the individual 22.

21. On 02/26/25 at 10:06p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Juvenile. On arrival officers counted 110 patrons exiting the bar with a sense of urgency, some exiting out rear and side doors. Officers made entry and began to check ID's of the remaining patrons, however, found the majority did not have ID's or utilizing a UV Blacklight, found all

the remaining ID's to be fake from out of state. An interview of the patrons revealed some patrons flushed their ID down the toilet, some stated they were never asked for ID, and others stated they didn't have an ID.

The Agent was interviewed and stated they scanned roughly 150 patron's ID's; confiscated and denied entry to patrons in which the scanner detected the ID's were fake or expired. The officer showed the Agent the ID's they confiscated utilizing the Blacklight and what was found to be fake on the ID's. The Agent stated as long as the scanner came back green, they assumed the ID was good. The licenses were found to be in a folder and not posted in a visible manner. The capacity for the establishment was 99, however, the Agent stated they believed they had no more than 100 patrons. The officer advised them of their count, to which the Agent stated they had no idea there were that many patrons and did not have a clicker at the front door. The Agent was cited for the following violations: Allow Underage on Premise-Dismissed (Citation# 0681L9CGMM) License Establishment Exceed Occupancy – Found Guilty and fined \$3210.00 (Citation # 0681KX84GO)

22. On 05/08/25 at 11:00p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an Underage Drinking Complaint. On arrival officers observed the bar to most likely be at max capacity. Officers made an announcement that if you were under 21 you needed to leave the bar. At that time approximately 95% of the patrons exited. An interview of a few patrons revealed they were not 21. The Agent was on scene and stated they utilize the scanner to detect fake ID's and had confiscated 19 ID's that night. The officer asked the Agent to explain the majority of the bar being underage, to which they stated they cannot catch them all. The officer further noted they have issued citations on multiple occasions to underage patrons at the bar and this has been an ongoing problem. The Agent was issued a citation for Allow Consumption of Alcohol by Underage-Dismissed without Prejudice (Citation #J981NNZLZB) and Allow Underage on Premises-Dismissed without Prejudice (Citation #J981NNZLZC).

This report is written by Officer Kathleen MURPHY assigned to Milwaukee Police Department District 5, Early Power Shift, Squad #5262 DVHRT.

On Wednesday, September 25, 2024, at approximately 2:32pm Jiniah L MCKINNEY (B/F, 11/9/2003) entered the District 5 lobby requesting to report that she had been drugged while drinking at Axel's Inn located at 2859 N Oakland Avenue.

Victim's Initial Statement:

MCKINNEY stated that last night around 11:30pm she went to Axel's Inn on Oakland with two friends. MCKINNEY stated that she presented the owner, Eric A RASMUSSEN (W/M, 3/14/1970), with a fake identification card. MCKINNEY stated that her fake ID has her picture and name but has a legal (21+) date of birth.

MCKINNEY stated that RASMUSSEN served her a beer and shot, and she took the shot immediately and was drinking the beer. MCKINNEY stated that she left the beer on the bar and went outside.

MCKINNEY stated when she returned, she went back to drinking her beer. MCKINNEY stated that she felt different when she began drinking her beer again.

MCKINNEY stated that shortly after, by 12:30am on 9/25/2024 she was completely incapacitated and had to be carried out of the bar by friends.

MCKINNEY stated she went to Ascension St Francis Hospital where she was urine tested. MCKINNEY stated she left before getting her paperwork but was called by St Mary's staff and told that she tested positive for Rohypnol.

MCKINNEY stated that the owner, RASMUSSEN, has a reputation for drugging people at the bar. MCKINNEY stated that she knows someone that tested positive for ketamine last week.

Upon arrival, I observed no customers inside the location and observed only employees. I spoke to the manager/license agent identified as Eric A. RASMUSSEN (W/M, 3-14-1970) who stated all customers were just leaving the location and only employees should be left inside. I also advised RASMUSSEN why police were at the location which are indicated in the CAD notes above.

RASMUSSEN was cooperative during this investigation and stated he has a digital ID scanner that scans

ID and stores the information so he can have access to any information. RASMUSSEN stated this device stores identifications, names, dates/times, and number of times customers visit the store. RASMUSSEN stated all IDs get scanned and he has employees at the doors verifying age and to scan IDs.

RASMUSSEN provided all license premises information which was displayed in a picture frame behind the bar.

I later spoke to the caller Owen HOWE, (W/M 07-10-2007) who stated he received pictures from his friend he knows as "Kevin SORIA" on snapchat of alcoholic beverages and stating he was at this location. HOWE stated he only called police because "SORIA" was "trash talking" him on social media and he became upset. HOWE stated he was never at this location and was in a different county.

I later called RASMUSSEN who was able to provide information on "SORIA" from his digital ID scanner. RASMUSSEN provided ID information containing Kevin SORIA FLORES (W/M, 7-9-2002), Illinois ID #S61450002195.

This report is being written by PO Justin M. SILKEY, assigned to Milwaukee Police Department District 1, Late Power Shift, Squad 1460. On Wednesday, February 26th, 2025, at approximately 10:06PM, while in full duty uniform equipped with a Axon body worn camera activated and in a marked squad. I was dispatched to a Trouble with Juvenile located at 2859 N Oakland Ave #1, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Prior to my arrival P.O. Christian GARRIDO, stood at the front eastern facing door and counted out loud the number of people who exited the bar. P.O. GARRIDO had his Axon body camera activated while he did this. P.O. GARRIDO, counted 110 people who exited Axes bar. When Sgt. MAXCEY arrived, he had Officers go to the other exits to make sure no one entered the tavern via a different door. There is a large fence in the back western alleyway behind the bar so no one can enter the rear door without climbing a ten foot fence.

Upon my arrival I observed a large group of males and females leaving Axles establishment with a sense of urgency upon officers' arrival. The large group of males and females were attempting to the exit the establishment from the back door and side door when officers arrived. The remaining people inside the establishment were all asked to show some form of identification to show that they were of legal age to consume alcohol. Most of the people that the officers stopped to check identification either did not have any identification on them or had a fake identification card from another State on them.

I conducted a check of identification cards myself and used a UV Blacklight that I have and found that all the identifications cards were fakes. Some of the people that we questioned admitted that they did not have an identification card on them or that it was a fake identification card. Some of the other individuals admitted that they flushed theirs down the toilet upon our arrival or that the bar staff never even checked or asked for their identification

cards.

I spoke to licensed premise manager and owner later identified as Eric A RASMUSSEN (M/W 3-14-70). RASMUSSEN stated they have an identification card scanner and provided it to us to show that he scanned roughly 150 patrons' identification cards. RASMUSSEN stated that if the card was fake or expired that it would show the color red or yellow. RASMUSSEN stated that a red or yellow indicator tells him that the card is either fake or expired and he would deny them entry to his establishment and take the identification card from them. RASSUMEN showed me the fake identification cards he took from people tonight that came back as red on the scanner stated it was a fake identification card.

I showed RASSUMEN the UV blacklight that I used and showed him identification cards that were scanned by him and showed what was fake about them. RASSUMEN stated he had no idea that it was fake. RASSUMEN stated the scanner came back green and he thought it was good. I told RASSUMEN that I conduct a DOT check on the identification cards and that not one of them came back to a legal age or never came back to a person at all.

I asked to see RASSUMEN license which was posted on the wall but did not have the current one inside the frame. The new license was inside a folder under the cash register. I noticed on the license that the establishment was only aloud

to have 99 occupants inside the bar. I asked RASSUMEN how many patrons he had inside the establishment, and he thought no more than 100 patrons. RASSUMEN had no clicker at the front door and could not provide an accurate number to me. I told him upon our arrival that he had well over 100 people inside the establishment and that 1 officer had counted at least 110 people that walked out the front door one by one. RASSUMEN stated he had no idea there was that many people inside the establishment. RASSUMEN was *cooperative* with the investigation. The business had one security officer on scene. They were unarmed.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. During my investigation for trouble with juvenile I did observe several violations in the licensed premise. The violations were Ordinance 90-19-2-A-1 which is Allow Underage on Premises and Ordinance 85-23-4-A which is Licensed establishment exceeding occupy limit. There were 2 citations written for those violations which were #0681L9CGMM and #0681KX84G0. We also gave out 10 citations for Ordinance 90-18-3 Misrepresenting Age to Receive Alcohol. Those Citations numbers were #0681JXM80X, M582HQT5JQ, M582HQT5JR, M582HQT5JS, M582HQT5JT, M582HQT5JV, 0681L9CGMH, 0681L9CGMJ, 0681L9CGMK, and J981GK13G3. One citation was also issued for Resisting/obstructing an Officer.

The citations were delivered on Wednesday March 5th at 10:25PM and handed to the owner Eric A Rasmussen (M/W 3-14-70).

The business plans to buy a UV Blacklight to find the fake identification cards and to eliminate nuisance activity.

This report is written by P.O. Richard MICHALAK, assigned to District One, Late Power.

On Thursday, May 8th, 2025 at approximately 11:00 P.M., P.O. SILKEY and I (SQD 1420) along with Sgt. MAXCEY (SQD 1411) were dispatched to Axle's Inn located 2859 N. Oakland Ave., for an underage drinking complaint.

On arrival, I observed several individuals standing outside the main entrance that looked under the age of twenty-one. I entered the bar and observed that it was probably at max capacity and the individuals looked very young. As I walked through the bar I talked to one individual and he stated he was not twenty-one and was actually nineteen. I walked through the entire bar, verbally made an announcement that if you were not twenty-one you needed to leave the bar. At the time we only had three police officers, so it would have been impossible to stop all individuals to check their Id's. After I made the announcement, I would say 95% of the bar exited. My body worn camera was on the entire time and captured all the individuals leaving the bar. P.O. SILKEY had two individuals stopped at this point and both were under the age of twenty-one.

I spoke with Eric RASMUSSEN (W/M, 3-14-70) the owner of Axels Inn. RASMUSSEN stated that he has an ID scanner when individuals walk into his bar and it supposes to tell him whether or not it's a fake or good license. RASMUSSEN stated that night he had taken nineteen fake Identification cards. I asked RASMUSSEN how does he account for 95% of the crowd leaving his bar that were under the age of twenty-one? RASMUSSEN stated that he is trying and can not catch them all. It should be noted that RASMUSSEN had two other individuals checking ID's at the front door besides him.

Allowing under age individuals into Axel's has been an on going issue. We issued two tickets "for misrepresentation of age," to the two individuals. Both were under the age of twenty-one and both admitted to consuming alcohol. Citations were issued on scene.


