WHEREAS, *For his Eagle project, Jacob Hall Tretow and his fellow scouts emptied, washed, scrubbed, repaired, painted and reorganized a store room used for stocking kitchen supplies, seasonal and liturgical decorations and sleeping bags for the homeless at St. Matthias Parish in Milwaukee; and*

WHEREAS, *Jacob Hall Tretow's commitment to his fellow scouts and his willingness to always complete the task that is required of him has placed him in the highest rank of the Boy Scouts of America; therefore be it*
