The Health Department is submitting the following grant resolutions for Common Council approval. All resolutions approve the application for the funding only.

<u>Lead Outreach Grant</u> - This grant funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development will develop and implement intensive and coordinated education, screening and housing advocacy in the lead program's target area.

<u>HUD Asthma Grant</u> - This resolution authorizes the application for funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The grant will provide care coordination, in-house case management, environmental assessment and housing interventions to 400 children identified with persistent asthma.

<u>Lead Demonstration Project</u> - Also funded by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the grant will make an additional 1,295 housing units lead-safe and contract with a community-based organization to assure lead-safe and habitable housing the southside target areas.

<u>Lead Based Paint Hazard Control Grant</u> - This resolution authorizes the application for funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The grant will make an additional 870 housing units leadsafe and contract with three community-based organizations in support of neighborhood prevention activities.
