
Dear Ms. Perry:

This office is receipt of your claim in the amount of \$242.88, relating to damages sustained to your vehicle when it was struck by a falling piece of a light pole in the 6000 block of North 76th Street on January 4, 2001.

The Infrastructure Services Division records indicate they received a call regarding the defective light pole on January 5, 2001 upon notification the division repaired the light pole on the same date. Prior to your loss the City did not have any notice of the defective light pole. Because the City did not have any notice, it cannot be held liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.
