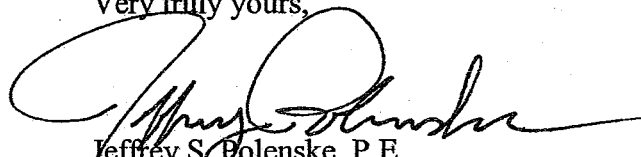
Dear Alderman Bohl:

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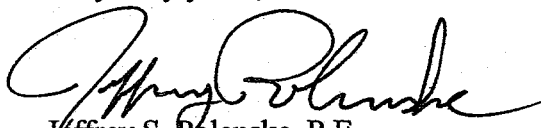

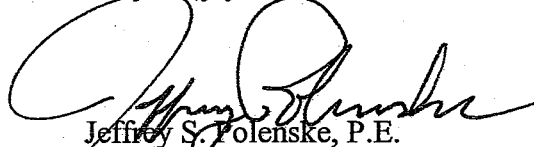
Dear Alderman Gordon:

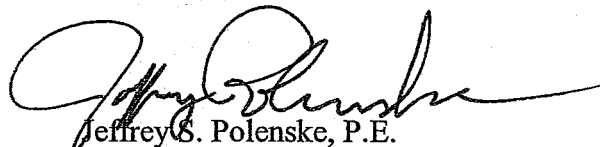

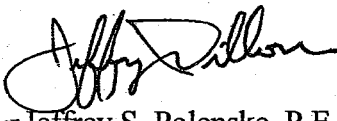
Dear Alderman Sanchez:

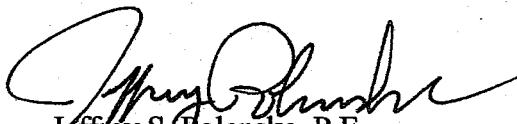

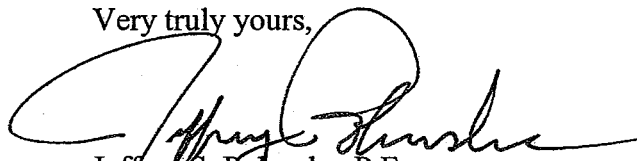
