Notice is hereby given that an ordinance that was introduced at the October 23, 2007 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:

Substitute ordinance relating to the change in zoning from Two-Family Residential to a Detoiled Planned Development known as Humbldt Commons, on land located on the East Side of North Humboldt Boulevard and South of East Hadley Street, in the 3rd Aldermanic District

Humboldt Boulevard and South of East Hadley Street, in the 3rd Aldermanic District.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee ("Common Council"), do ordain as follows:

Part 1. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ("Code") a new section to read as follows:

Section 295-907(2)(2),0121.

(I) In accordance with the provisions of Section 295-907 of the Code relating to the establishment of planned development districts, the Common Council approves the subject Detailed Planned Development, a copy of which is ottached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully set forth herein.

(2) The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for the area described and bounded by the zoning line olong the right-of-way line of North Humboldt. Boulevard, a line 67 feet South and parallel to the south line of East Hadley Street and the zoning line along the east side of Gordon Park, from Two-Family Residential (RT4) to Detailed Planned Development (DPD).

(3) The requirements set forth in said detailed plan attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A, constitute the zoning regulations for the area contoined in such planned development district described, provided further, that the effect of the approval of such detailed plan is that such plan shall limit and control construction, location, use and operation of all land and structures included within the detailed plan to all conditions and limitations set forth in such detailed plan.

Part 2. Any persons, firm, company or corporation owning, controlling, or praging as a proper set and proper

Any persons, firm, company or corporation owning, controlling, or managing any building or premises wherein or whereon there shall be placed or there exists anything in viola-tion of the terms of this ordinance; or who shall build contrary to the plans or specifications submitted to and ap-proved by the Commissioner of the Department of City Development, or any person, firm, company or corporation who shall omit, neglect or refuse to do any act required in this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 200-19 of the Code.

Part 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of compared to the court of compared to the court of the co petent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separae, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions. The Common Council declares that it would have possed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion irre-spective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases or other portions be declared void or invalid.
