WHEREAS, ST. Sava Orthodox School started its winter musical program in December 2004 performing various plays and musicals, in June 2007 it had their first 8th grade graduation, and in June 2015 it had its ninth graduating class, and has a Slava every year for St. Cyril and Methodius; and

WHEREAS, ST. Sava Orthodox School is an active participant in the community, competing in sporting events, hosting science fairs, and art fairs, and collecting food and funds for a food pantry; now, therefore, be it
