Dear Alderman D'Amato,

We are writing to express our strong support for the proposed \$25 million city financing package for Manpower Inc.'s new headquarters in downtown Milwaukee. We endorse as a major downtown business, as neighbors on the river, and representing the \$45 million performing arts industry.

When weighing the benefits of city support, a development such as this needs to be viewed in the larger context of how it creates significant spin-off benefit to other existing businesses in downtown Milwaukee as well as how citizens are using their downtown.

The addition of 1000 employees to the downtown workforce makes an important contribution to the vitality of downtown and to the performing arts' ability to continue to attract new patrons for its programming. The annual BID #21 survey has shown for several years that the number one reason people come to live and play in downtown is the performing arts offerings.

Placing this development on the Milwaukee River puts Manpower Inc.'s employees within convenient distance of the performing arts venues along with our river and street festivals. It will also enable them to walk to the Bradley Center, the Water Street entertainment district and restaurants on Old World Third Street. The addition of Manpower Inc. will bring additional paying patrons through those doors.

Representing the performing arts so heavily concentrated downtown, we welcome the major reinvestment in the area brought about by Manpower choosing to locate its business in downtown Milwaukee. It can only enhance developments either underway or planned, and spur further development in and surrounding the park east corridor.

A decision to support a financing package isn't a decision just benefiting Manpower Inc. and its employees. It is, in effect, a decision to support the continued growth and vitality of downtown business and its employee attraction. It is a sound and creative business decision, and we encourage your positive support.
