Dear Commissioners:

I respectfully nominate Fire Captain Brian T. Moore to the rank of Battalion Chief. My reasons for recommending him for promotion are found below.

Fire Captain Moore has 19 ½ years of accomplished fire service with the department. He was appointed as a Fire Cadet in January 2004, became a Firefighter in March 2004, received his paramedic license in May of 2005, was promoted to Fire Lieutenant through a special process in February of 2010, was promoted to Fire Lieutenant via the FPC list in November of 2010, and promoted to Fire Captain in September 2014.

Fire Captain Moore has had a passion for firefighting and commitment to service throughout his career. He earned his associate degree in Fire Science from Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC) and completed the Milwaukee Fire Department (MFD) Professional Development Program, continuously developing his skills as an officer. For 14 years, he was a paramedic providing critical emergency medical care and retains his national accreditation.


As a Fire Captain for nine years, he demonstrated by example vital leadership qualities through his communication, coaching, and community engagement. In his role as Assistant Director of the Heavy Urban Rescue Team, he organized complex trainings and rescue operations. Fire Captain Moore has received awards for extraordinary rescue efforts, highlighting his quick thinking and expert actions taken under pressure.

Fire Captain Moore is completely ready to take on greater responsibility as a Battalion Chief. His incident command experience, focus on high morale, and relationship building skills will enable him to lead companies safely and effectively. He has developed strong prioritization and adaptability skills critical for managing multiple assignments and duties.

He serves as a commissioner on the Big Bend Fire & Police Commission, regularly implementing policies and procedures, collaborating on budget approvals, and overseeing recruitment, retention, and discipline of the fire and police departments' personnel. Also, during his off-duty time, he demonstrates community commitment by assisting, organizing, and participating in, an annual Down Syndrome Association of Wisconsin fundraiser.
