Dear Mr. Zielinski:

The Health Department is submitting grant resolutions for the following programs:

Lead Poisoning Prevention Grant - This is a continuing grant from the Centers for Disease Control through the State of Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services. The purpose of this grant is to support comprehensive and coordinated services to lead-poisoned children and their families.

Healthy Homes Grant - This is a new grant for the Health Department funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The project will assess the level of environmental allergens in the homes of children with severe asthma. The resolution will authorize the application for the funding.

Congenital Disorders Grant - Funded by the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services, this funding allows us to screen every infant born in Wisconsin for 21 rare disorders.

SURVNET Grant - The SURVNET project is a county-wide system for reporting communicable diseases in Milwaukee. This funding from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services provides the Health Department with one position.

Well Women Health Initiative - This resolution amends C.C. File 001295 which approved the application, funding and expenditure of this grant. The contract amount has been doubled to allow for a 12-month timeframe.
