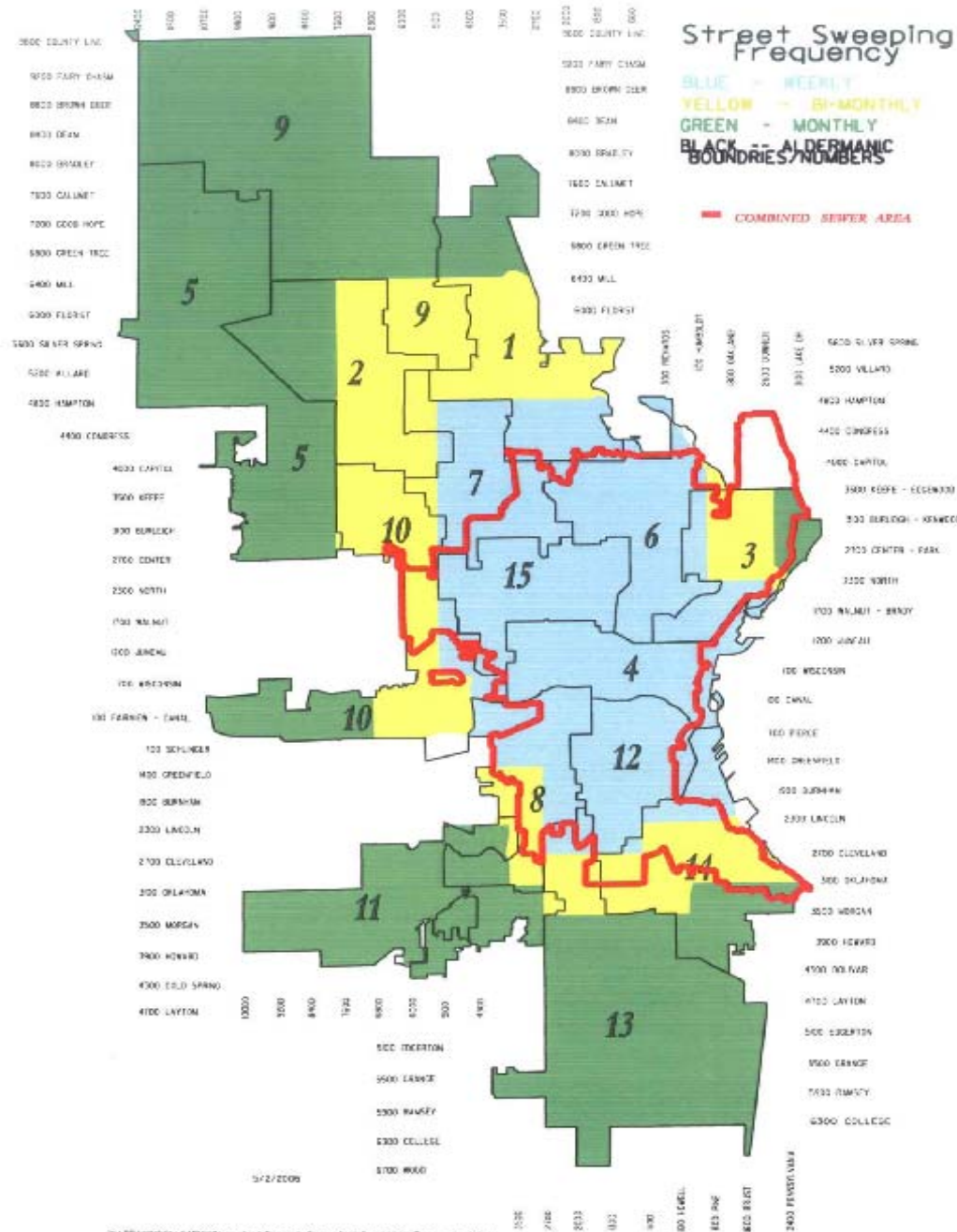

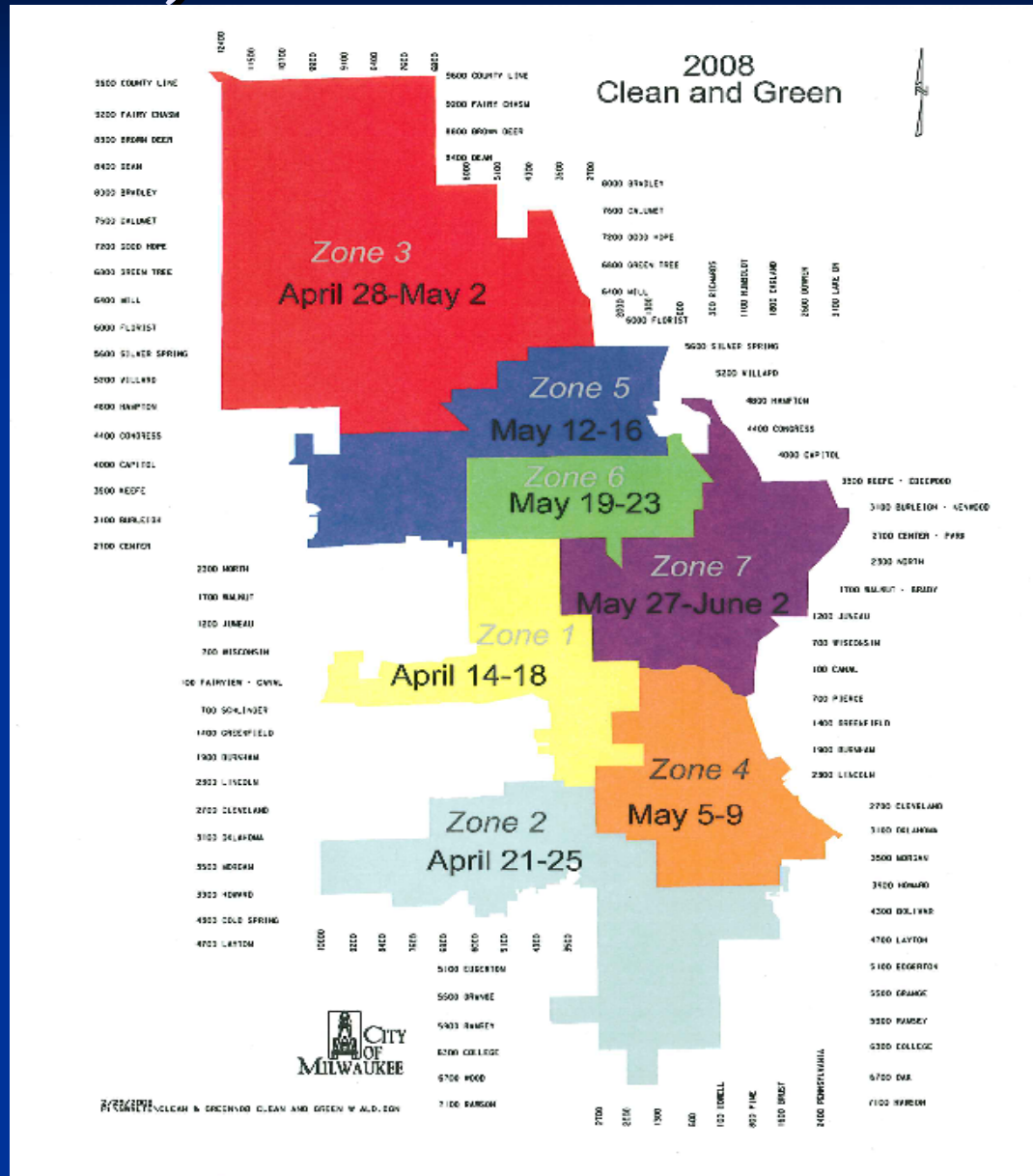
Summer Self Help

Weekend Boxes

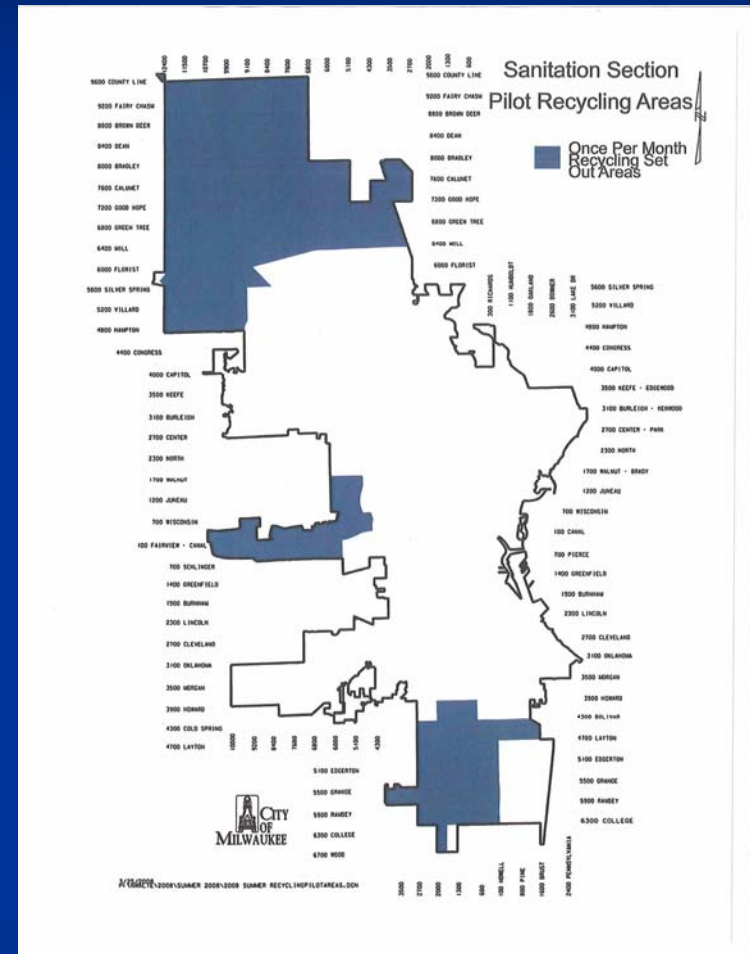
- CDBG funding in prior years - \$295,000
