- Reaccreditation awarded

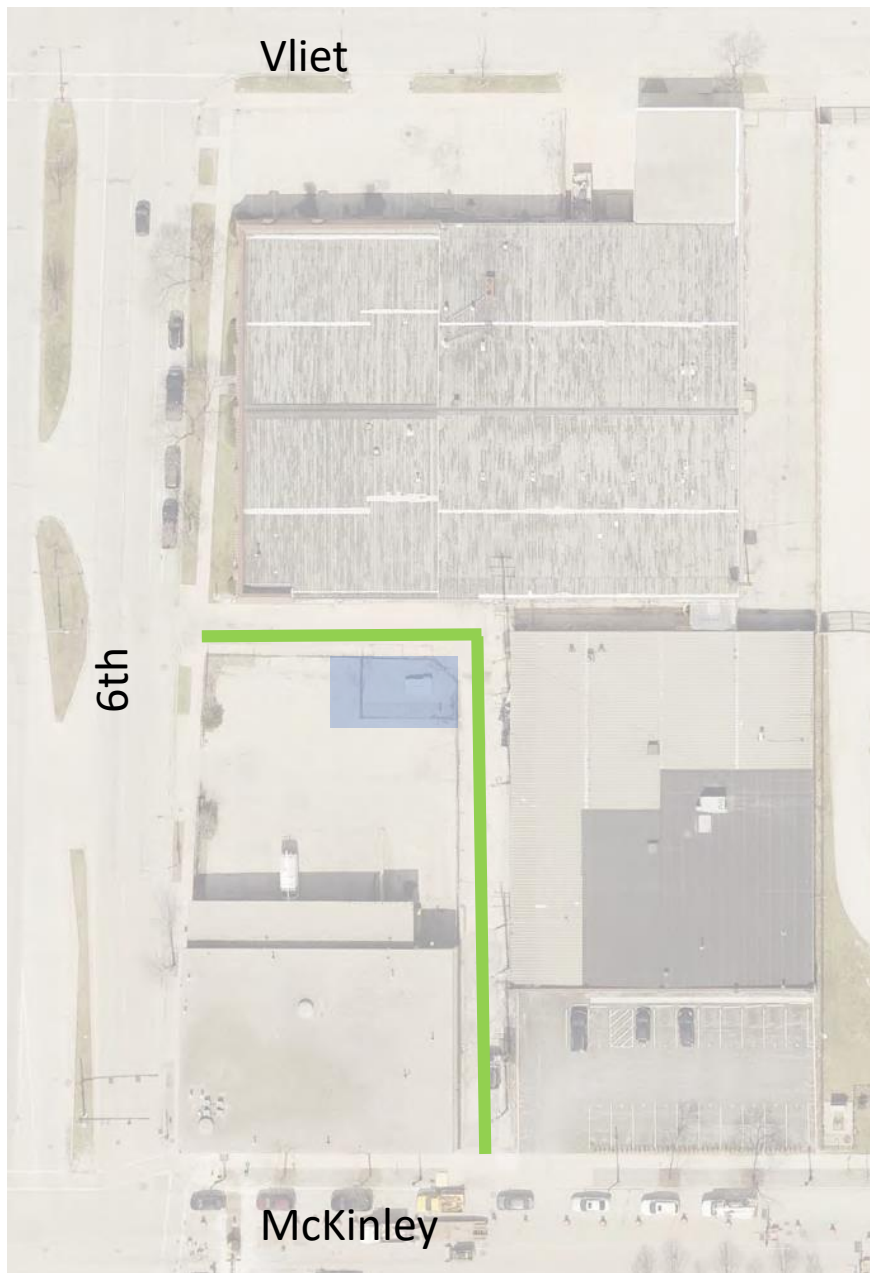
