If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 07/07/19 at 11:05am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4020 W. North Avenue for a subject with gun complaint. Investigation revealed that a lawn maintenance van parked on the applicants' property and began doing yard work on the property behind his location. The applicant confronts the subject and an argument ensues. The applicant calls police and the driver of the van was told not to park on the property.
2. On 09/30/19 at 4:59am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4020 W. North Avenue for an entry complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject pried off a window and screen and took property. A report was filed.
3. On 01/20/20 at 9:25pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4020 W. North Avenue for a shot spotter complaint. Investigation revealed that a customer parked his vehicle in the lot and entered the establishment. While inside, two subjects tried to steal his vehicle. The owner of the vehicle, seeing this, went outside and confronted the subjects. The subjects fled the parking lot, but while doing so, one of them, fired a handgun at the owner of the vehicle, striking his accomplice. The store security and applicant were on scene and cooperated fully with the investigation.
4. On 01/31/20 at 12:29pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4020 W. North Avenue for a Theft complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject, after getting his credit card declined, left the store with the property he was going to buy.

5. On 10/17/20 at 11:43am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4020 W. North Avenue for a subject with gun complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject entered the establishment and tried to buy a tobacco product. When the applicant asked the subject for identification to purchase the product, the subject began to argue with the applicant. Another subject then entered the store and also began arguing with the applicant. That subject threatened to shoot the applicant and grabbed at his waistband causing the applicant to retrieve his firearm and put it in his pocket. The applicant called police and the subjects left. The applicant was able to provide video.
6. On 11/01/20 at 10:31pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4020 W. North Avenue for a fight complaint. Upon arrival, there was no fight and the business was closed. The police called the caller (applicant) who stated that he observed the fight on surveillance video and called police.
7. On 11/05/20 at 10:05am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4020 W. North Avenue for an alarm complaint. Upon police arrival, they determined it was a false alarm.
8. On 12/02/20 at 3:29pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4020 W. North Avenue for an accident. Investigation revealed that that a vehicle pulled into the parking lot and while it was reversing, struck a person who was walking behind the vehicle. The applicant was able to provide video surveillance of the incident.
9. On 12/10/20 at 10:30am, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 4020 W. North Avenue. During the investigation, officers found that the applicant had an expired food and tobacco license. When the applicant was asked about this, he stated that he thought he could sell the products while he was awaiting approval for his licenses. When told by officers he could not, the applicant put a sign on the cooler saying "not for sale" and had an employee remove all the perishable food from the coolers. The applicant said he would talk with his book keeper about the cigarette license.

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10. On 04/28/21 at 1:00p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 4020 W. North Av. This was in regards to complaints regarding single cigarette sales. No evidence of single cigarette sales was observed and all employees denied selling any single cigarettes.

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11. On 01/19/23 at 11:04a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Sexual Assault at 4020 W. North Ave. The caller/victim stated the agent fondled them in 2022. The agent was not on scene and at the time of the report, the investigation was still active.
12. On 07/15/23 at 4:00p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Burglary at 4020 W. North Av. Investigation revealed a subject gained entry via the roof, utilizing a hatchet like tool and climbed down a ladder. The suspect attempted to removed the ATM machine, causing damage. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

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The following items pertain to the business at 4020 W. North Ave.

13. On 11/09/24 at 1:40p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shots Fired. Video surveillance at the business depicts an employee and security chasing a subject out of the store and attempting to pull the subject out of a car, when security discharged their firearm at

the subject. At that time the video surveillance shows the caller driving past the location. Further review showed the helper, hand the employee the firearm, and pick up what is believed to be a casing from the parking lot. The employee appears to conceal the firearm behind tobacco products and never called the police. (2 reports)

14. On 12/11/24 at 11:36a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Shots Fired. Investigation revealed the business was not involved but was the caller. The business was cooperative and allowed officers to view video surveillance of a suspect firing shots at a moving vehicle. The victim refused to cooperate
15. On 07/10/25 at 10:28a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon. Investigation revealed this had nothing to do with the business, other than they allowed officers to review video surveillance of the incident. An altercation between two parties in the parking lot, led to the caller stating the other party pointed a firearm at them. The business was cooperative.
16. On 07/12/25 at 8:31a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Property Damage. Investigation revealed a suspect cause damage to an employee's vehicle by jumping on it. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

This report is written by P.O. Jazzmin KING, assigned to District 3 Early Power Shift, Squad 3271.

On Saturday, November 9th, 2024, at 1:40 PM, P.O. Demetrious HUDSON and I were dispatched to 4020 W North Ave for a Shots fired complaint to assist squad 3235 P.O. Justin BENERO and P.O. Michael MARX.

Upon our arrival we observed video surveillance per squad 3216 SGT Joseph STOEBICH.

The cad states CLR HEARD 1-2 SHOTS FIRED, SAID SHE WAS DRIVING AND 1 BULLET HIT HER CAR. BELIEVES IT HIT HER TIRE. CLR IS IN A BLK CHEVY SUV, IN TRAFFIC. SAID SHE SAW 3 UNKNOWN B/M RUNNING...#1 WRG WHITE TSHIRT, #2 DREDS, NO DESCRIP OF #3...ALSO SAW A BLK CAR (UNKNOWN MAKE/MODEL DRIVE AWAY, UNKNOWN DIRECTION. CLR IS NOT HURT.

P.O. BENERO spoke with the caller identified as Ashley M DELUCA (W/F 12-03-1985). DELUCA stated she was driving her vehicle Westbound on W North Av, approximately two blocks East of where we met DELUCA. DELUCA stated she was passing some sort of convenient store, when she observed multiple subjects in an Altercation. DELUCA stated she then heard a gunshot, and her car immediately malfunctioned, and she was unable to accelerate. Officers did not observe any bullet holes on the perimeter of the vehicle; however, we were unable to observe any damage that may have occurred underneath the vehicle.

All officers on scene reviewed video surveillance footage. Per P.O. BENERO video footage showed an unknown subject standing at the cashout and attempting to buy a black and mild cigar. ABOHADBA stated that the subject did not want to pay for his black and mild until ABOHADBA handed it to him. The video shows the subject run out of the store and get into a vehicle. ABOHADBA and another subject from the store run out to the parking lot after the subject. ABOHADBA stated that the subject he ran out with helps around the store occasionally and ABOHADBA only knows him as RUBY. It appeared from the video that ABOHADBA and RUBY were trying to pull the subject out of the car. The subject continues to drive Eastbound in the parking lot, when RUBY pulls a Black Firearm from his waistband and points it at the rear of the fleeing vehicle, before discharging one round towards the rear of the fleeing vehicle. The video then shows RUBY walk up the vehicle and it appears that the subjects throw something out of the vehicle at RUBY. It should be noted that while watching the video, you can observe DELUCAS vehicle travelling Westbound on W North Av.

The fleeing subject then pulls out of the driveway and turns East onto W North Av, then turning South on N 40th St.

The video then shows ABOHADBA and RUBY enter back into the store and walk to the area behind the cash registers, which is secluded by glass windows and doors from the rest of the store. The video shows RUBY and ABOHADBA talking to each other before RUBY hands ABOHADBA a Black handgun. ABOHADBA then places the firearm on a shelf behind multiple cigarillo boxes, concealing the firearm from public view. RUBY leaves the frame of video for a short period time before returning into the frame, this time wearing a black jacket, he previously did not have on. RUBY can be seen walking out of the store, into the parking lot and picking up a small item off the ground, believed by officers to be a spent casing.

ABOHADNA did not call the Police regarding. While speaking with ABOHADNA he stated that he did not know he had to call the police.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date and expire Tuesday, December 10th, 2024.

This report is written by Police Officer Demetrious HUDSON assigned to District 3, Day Shift.

On Saturday, November 9th, 2024 I was requested by Sgt Stoebich to respond to a Shots Fired incident which occurred at the location of 4020 W North Avenue, in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Upon arrival, I was briefed by officers on scene that the owner was seen on video chasing a subject out of the location, attempting to snatch him out of his vehicle at which point, the security guard on scene fired one shot at the vehicle.

The owner and security guard are then seen on video returning into the store and the security guard handing a firearm to the owner. The security guard then fled the location.

Furthermore, the location had an unknown black male at the location who went behind the register and retrieved one of two firearms located under the register and run outside as the incident unfolded.

While on scene, the owner stated he wasn't sure if he should have called police because it was in the parking lot. I advised him that he owns the parking lot as it's on the property and is responsible for the entire location.

It should also be noted, the owner failed to call police regarding the incident.

Additionally, while on scene, behind the register, I observed a box of razor blades, digital scales, and an abundance of sandwich bags which are items known to aid in street level narcotic activity (I.e selling or using).

Also on scene, located were two additional firearms behind the counter.

There were approximately 4 squads that responded to the scene with 1 Sgt.

According to CAD notes, the caller was a woman in her vehicle traveling westbound on W. North Avenue when the shot occurred. The caller stated her vehicle was struck by gun fire, which caused her vehicle to stop operating, however, there was no bullet/fragments located.

I did observe the licenses of the premises, however, they were behind the register unable to be seen by customers. They were on a cork board in the hallway which led to the rear office. All licenses appeared to be up to date.

This location is not deemed a nuisance, however, will be monitored for future activity.

The owner was arrested for aiding and abetting.

This concludes my report.

On 12/11/24. at approximately 11:36 AM, Squad 3253 (PO Daniel GONZALES and I) responded to 4020 W. North Ave for a shots fired call for service. This is located in the City and County of Milwaukee. This location is a small grocery store (Brothers Grocery) located on the northside of W. North Ave. There's a parking lot that belongs to the business just south of the structure.

Initial Investigation:

Upon our arrival to the location, we met with the owner of the business who stated that he observed the following suspect shoot at a moving vehicle.

Suspect Description: B/M, 600/180, wearing a black jacket, black hoodie with the hood up, black pants, white shoes and armed with a silver over black handgun with an extended capacity magazine.

The suspect appeared to be shooting at a white older model Mazda SUV that was also at the business but was driving away at the time of the shots fired. The owner stated that he believed that the suspect only fired two shots before fleeing from the location going northbound in the alley.

The owner of the business showed me surveillance footage from the store which corroborated the owners story.

Surveillance footage of the incident was captured on my body warm camera.

While speaking with the owner about the incident, the alleged victim called the store and asked the

owner if she would be able to observe the surveillance video to see who shot at her. I attempted to speak to the victim over the phone who stated that she did not want to come to the store or report the incident to the police and that she only wanted to view the video for herself.

PO GONZALES located two spent 9mm luger casings inside the parking lot. These casing were collected and placed as Evidence under Milwaukee Police Department Inventory Number: 24034594. PO GONZALES also took numerous photos of the scene an the casings recovered.

At the time of this report, the suspect and "victim" remains unknown.

This report is written by P.O. Daniel SCOTT, assigned to District 3, Day Shift.

On Thursday, July 10, 2025 at 10:28am, Squad 3150 (P.O. Ryan MILLER and I) was dispatched to 4020 W North Av, Brothers Plus Grocery, for a Weapon call for service. We were in a marked MPD squad with emergency lights and audible siren. We were both in full duty uniform with badges affixed to our outermost garments and we were equipped with Axon bodyworn cameras.

Upon arrival, I interviewed the caller, Mary E BROWN (b/f 06-30-71), who stated that she and her daughter had been involved in an altercation in the Brother Plus Grocery parking lot which escalated to the other party pointing a firearm towards them. BROWN stated that she and her daughter, Lastarsia B RAY (b/f 05-12-94), parked in the lot at approximately 9:55am. BROWN stated that RAY entered the store and exited shortly thereafter. BROWN stated that as RAY backed up their vehicle from the parking spot, a silver Ford Edge entered the parking lot and there was almost a collision. BROWN stated that the driver of Edge called them "bitches" and displayed a handgun on his hip as he entered the store. BROWN stated that RAY drove off but quickly returned and observed the driver of the Edge as he was now exiting the store. BROWN stated that RAY showed the driver of the Edge her middle finger as she drove by. BROWN stated that she observed him unholster his handgun and point it at their car as they fled eastbound on W North Av. BROWN demonstrated the suspect pointing the firearm by raising her arm to a 90 degree angle and stated she observed the handgun pointed directly at their vehicle. BROWN stated that the suspect's actions caused them to fear for their safety.

Per the security camera footage and RAY's photo, the suspect is a black male, 30 to 35 years old, 6'01, 230lbs, dreadlocks tied in a high ponytail, dark complexion, short beard, LSW black t-shirt with colorful logo on chest, black sweats, black socks, and black slides. Suspect was armed with a small black handgun.
