File 061414 is a resolution authorizing acceptance and funding of an ATF/Violent Crimes Impact Team (VCIT) grant.

Background

- 1. Through the VCIT Grant, the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives will make federal funds available to the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) for long-term investigations into violent criminals.
- 2. The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for a VCIT grant in the amount of \$28,000.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of this grant is to fund long-term investigations into violent criminals who are associated with street gangs or well organized crime units.
- 2. Grant funds would be used to fund MPD overtime expenses related to long-term investigations into violent criminals and other safety measures necessary to mitigate the effects of street gangs or well organized crime units.
- 3. The grant period extends from October 1, 2006 to September 30, 2007.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total cost of this grant-funded project is \$28,000.
- 2. The grantor share is \$28,000, with a City share of \$0.
- 3. The MPD will use the grant proceeds to fund \$28,000 in police officer overtime expenditures.
