File # 041720 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Milwaukee Area Violent Criminal Enterprise Task Force Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a Milwaukee Area Violent Criminal Enterprise Task Force grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation.
- 2. This is a new grant.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of the task force is to deploy police department officers on overtime to assist member of the FBI to disrupt Milwaukee area criminal enterprises.
- 2. Enterprises targeted include gang activities, drug trafficking, money laundering, intimidation and extortion.
- 3. This grant encompasses the period of February 1, 2005 through September 30, 2005.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total of this grant is \$64,608 with \$39,110 provided by the grantor and \$25,498 provided by the city including indirect costs (\$6,771) associated with grant administration.
- 2. The city share of personnel costs includes \$11,195 for overtime and fringe benefits.
