Common Council File 041339 contains a resolution amending the city's prevailing wage rates for boilermakers and their contrators. The file contains a letter from the Milwaukee Buildings and Trade Council (MBTC), dated January 12, 2005, updating the wage and fringe benefit rates for various classifications of building trades workers (specifically boilermakers) employed in the private construction industry for 2005.

Adoption of this resolution will amend the minimum rates of pay and fringe benefits, per the attached schedule, for various workers employed by the private construction industry, but engaged in public works contracts with the City of Milwaukee. The rates of pay will be incorporated into the City's Prevailing Wages Resolution.

By special order from the State of Wisconsin, the city is exempt from applying for a special wage determination for each construction project as long as the city periodically adopts state-provided wage schedules into its contract wage scale.

The fiscal impact of this file is unknown. It will depend on the nature of the construction projects undertaken in 2005 and the percentage increase in wages and benefits.

RECOMMENDATION: APPROVE THIS AMENDMENT THAT MAINTAINS CITY COMPLIANCE WITH THE STATE PREVAILING WAGE LAW.
