A construction of a bullet resistance enclosure with biometric keypad, is being made for the business. Further discussed was that all employees now will take an orientation and annually deterrence robbery program. Finally, additional lights were placed on the business. This concluded the meeting.

Police spoke with on site security who stated that a subject was sleeping in their car by the gas pumps. The subject has been in the car for over 20 minutes. On Tuesday, March 02, 2021, at approximately 11:25 PM, Sq. 6241 (myself and P.O. Harold ALMAS) were dispatched to a Theft complaint at the listed location of 369 E. Oklahoma Av (Speedway) located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

Upon arrival I spoke to the caller who was verbally identified as Kristen E KRAFT (w/f, 07/31/93) who stated that at approximately 11:15 PM she observed a white male approximately 5'10, slim build, wearing a white fabric covid mask, dirty gray coat, dirty gray pants, and a green fabric back pack enter the store.

KRAFT stated the subject appeared to be looking around and procrastinating. KRAFT stated she was helping a customer at the register when she observed the unknown subject crouch down in an aisle. KRAFT stated she finished her transaction with the customer, and then walked over to an aisle where she could see the unknown subject crouched down on the ground placing items inside of a backpack.

KRAFT told the subject to remove the items from his backpack, and return them. KRAFT stated the subject moved from the north end entrance/exit doors to the locked east entrance/exit doors, unlocked the doors and fled south bound on S. Howell Av without paying for the items, permanently depriving the victim of their product.

KRAFT and P.O. ALMAS conducted an inventory of the items taken. The following items were taken; KRAFT stated the subject obtained 4 Suzy Q's, 6 Banana twinkies, and 6 Ding Dongs for a total of \$34.

KRAFT stated the subject passed the last point of sale at approximately 11:20 PM. The commission of this crime was done intentionally and without consent.

Throughout this investigation KRAFT was the only cashier/employee on the premise and was cooperative with law enforcement personnel. There were not any violations to report regarding this incident.

This report was written by Police Officer Fabian GARCIA assigned to District Six-Early Power, Squad 6264, Community Liaison and Community Prosecution Unit.

On Monday, March 15, 2021, at 3:00 pm, my partner Officer Michael Ward and I, had a meeting with Speedway representatives in regards to their nuisance abatement letter at 369 E. Oklahoma Avenue.

Speedway representatives present at the meeting were Speedway Manager Logan P. ROBBINS (w/m, 06/25/96), Speedway Reginal Manager Richard T. YOST (w/m, 08/20/73), Speedway District Manager Adrian M. POULISSE (w/m, 09/17/85), and Speedway Division Loss Prevention Specialist John Cunningham.

Mr. POULISSE discussed that Speedway has started an incident report program, where any incidents that occur within their business employees can file a report which he reads and files and then compile all the information. With this program it can assist them in identifying individuals who are constantly causing issues at their businesses and communicating that information with the police department. It was also stated that Speedway tries to handle incidents inhouse before having to contact the police.

This location did hire onsite security, which is at the location four days out of the week 9pm-5am. Friday and Saturday being permanent days and two additional rotating days throughout the week. It was stated that security is planned to be at the location at least until the bullet resistant security glass enclosure is installed. Measurements have been made for the bullet resistant glass and is currently being built at this time. Mr. Cunningham stated they do not have an exact date when the resistant glass will be installed but it should be soon and will send Officer Ward and I an update regarding. Mr. Cunningham did state the entrance into the bullet resistant enclosure will be a biometric keypad. POULISSE did stated that they have their carton of cigarettes stored and locked behind two secured doors, which are key coded access.

In addition to the bullet resistant glass enclosure, magnetic locks will be placed on the entrance and exit door to ensure additional safety to their employees. Employees can lock the doors once out of the register area and once back they can unlock their doors from behind the glass enclosure. Employees are required annually to attend a robbery deterrence program in addition new-hire employees go through this training as well. ROBBINS did stated that additional lighting to the west side of the property was installed. An alley does run north and south on the west side of the property. Their are a total of 22 surveillance cameras throughout the business. 19 cameras are located in the interior of the property and three on the exterior of the property. YOST stated that they can look into placing and additional exterior camera on the west side of the property which faces the alley. 
