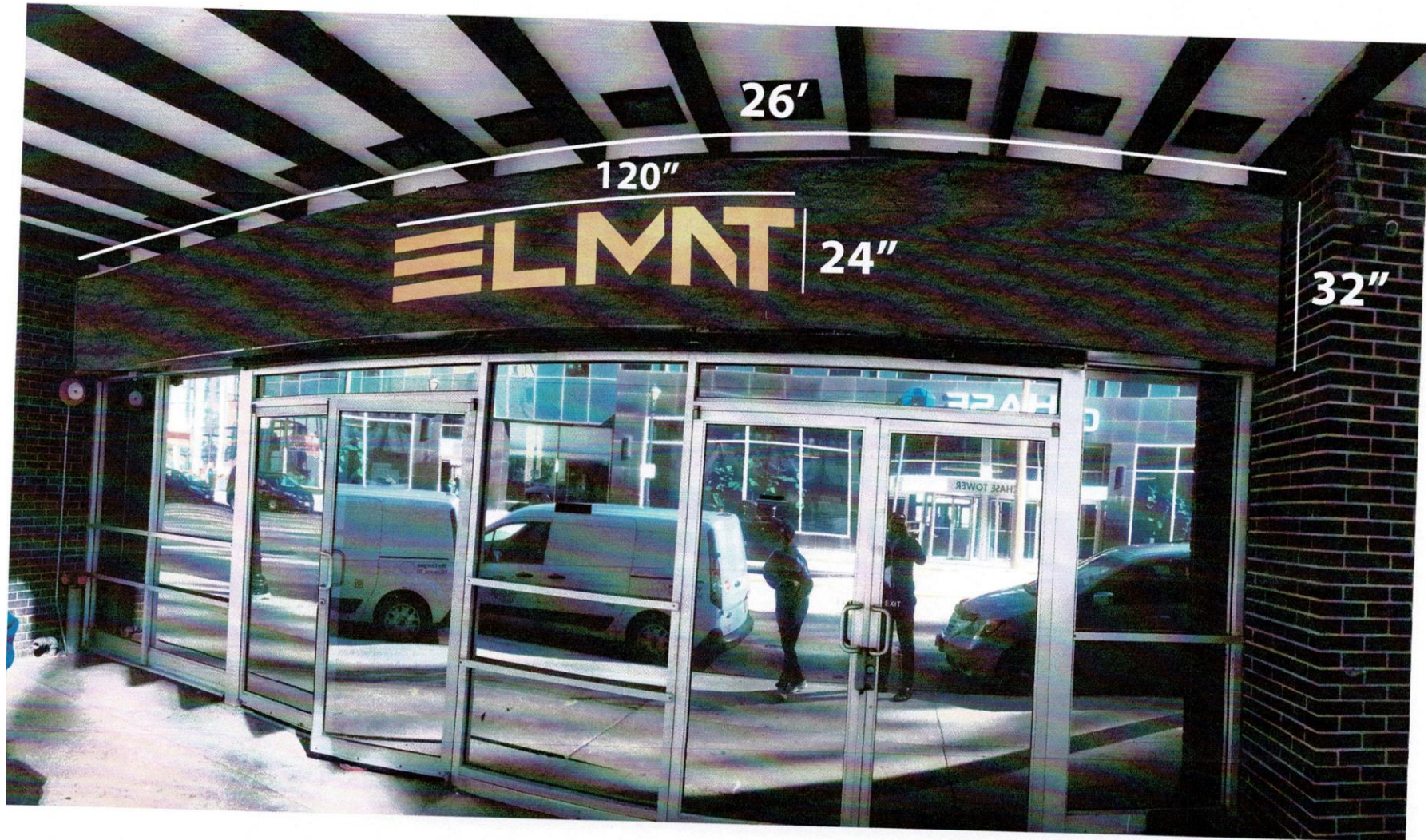
A SIGN PERMIT IS REQUIRED
