Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report was written by PO Fidah MUSTAFA assigned to District 1 Early Power.

On the evening of Thursday, April 28, 2022, District One Personnel performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. Our team consisted of an MPD Police Aide (PA Holly PELZEK PS# 031441), a Police Officer (PO Erica MARTINEZ PS# 029447), both of which were acting in a plainclothes capacity, and Police Officers Fidah MUSTAFA, Timothy KREJCI (Squad 1265) monitoring from a short distance in full duty uniforms. The Police Aide PELZEK is under the age of 21 (the legal age to purchase alcohol). This was verified by their respective Wisconsin Driver's License.

Prior to attempting any checks of licensed establishments, the PA PELZEK and PO MARTINEZ were given instructions. All members of this initiative were advised they were not allowed to consume any intoxicating beverages. If asked about their age, the members were told to tell the truth. PA PELZEK and PO MARTINEZ, were directed not to produce identification, and to walk away if asked to produce identification. It was explained that the police aide was to order an alcoholic beverage. It was explained that at all times the plainclothes police officer should be in visual sight and observe the financial transaction for alcoholic beverages.

After the briefing, the teams conducted underage checks at multiple taverns and convenient stores located throughout the District One Boundaries.

Police Officer MARTINEZ and Police Aide PELZEK gained entry to the Class "B" Licensed Tavern at 10:12 PM, Champion's Pub located at 2417 N. Bartlett Av. PA PELZEK successfully purchased a glass of Sprite & Crown Royal mixed alcoholic beverage, the bartender, did not ask PA PELZEK for identification and completed the sale of a Sprite & Crown Royal mixed drink for the amount of \$10. PA PELZEK exited the Champion's Pub at 10:20 PM.

Description of the clerk was provided by PA PELZEK is as follows

White Male

approximately 50 years of age 5'10", 230 pounds

Grey hair with a footlong beard, heavy set.

Based on PO MARTINEZ's description follow-up was conducted at Champion's Pub. On Saturday April 29, 2022 at 11:30 AM, and spoke with the Class "B" Licensee Robert R. GREENYA (W/M 03-30-1969). The bartender working the date and time of the transaction was identified as Matthew K. RYAN (W/M 09-16-1980).

RYAN was served a citation # 0681C3B002, along with a MC-715 form and a PF-6 in person for the sale of an alcoholic beverage to an underage customer, by PO KREJCI on Saturday, April 30, 2022 at 12:30 PM. Court date of October 25, 2022 at 8:30 AM.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 06/06/2022 at 10:35 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


