The significance of the request:

After being married to the love of her life Bishop Joe L. Hughes for 59 years and serving the body of Christ and the City of Milwaukee faithfully for 56 years, Dr. Lucy B. Hughes transitioned from this life to reward on Saturday, November 15, 2008 at LIFECARE Hospitals of Wisconsin in Pewaukee and we want her legacy to continue in as many ways as possible. She can be described as a dedicated wife and mother, gifted, creative, true visionary, trailblazer, history maker, preacher, teacher...a woman of great class and dignity, an encourager, cultivator, faithful; all this is true and yet not enough to capture all her essence for she truly was a woman before her time.

She started many ministries; the prison Ministry touched many lives and what the system couldn't do to change a person, Dr. L.B.s concern and care did. She was able to plant the seed of rehabilitation in many individuals before their release date was near. She also had a Nursing Home Ministry, gave out Thanksgiving baskets in the community and through her Samaritans Purse Ministry distributed hats, coats, gloves, scarves and food to the homeless. Mama you know you are the wind beneath my wings.



All my loneliness seemed to disappear when I looked into your eyes


