1. Describe the proposed ordinance or resolution.

The 2024-2025 Wisconsin Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force grant in the amount of \$80,000 will provide valuable resources to improve law enforcement capacity to detect, investigate, and apprehend criminals targeting children. The grant will provide funding for overtime, supplies, and equipment critical to investigations and digital forensics to enhance the effectiveness of the task force's response to online child pornography, child exploitation, and child enticement.
