Subject: HOUSING AVAILABILITY OUTSIDE OF 500 FOOT BUFFER ZONE.

This memo was prepared by the Legislative Reference Bureau at the request of the Office of the City Attorney.

The total number of residential buildings within the City of Milwaukee and the total number of housing units within those buildings are as follows*:

Total number of residential buildings within the City of Milwaukee 143,812
Total number of housing units within the City of Milwaukee 253,929

A map of the City of Milwaukee included in Common Council File No. 151657 and incorporated by reference shows a buffer zone in orange extending 500 feet around every school, licensed day care center, park, recreational trail, playground, youth center and place of worship.** A spreadsheet included in Common Council File No. 151657 and incorporated by reference shows the address of every residential building within the City of Milwaukee that is outside of the 500 foot buffer zone and the number of housing units per building.*

The following table compares the total number of residential buildings and housing units within the City of Milwaukee to the number of residential buildings and housing units that are within the City and also outside of the 500 foot buffer zone:
