With the introduction of the four-way stops on West Medford Avenue at West Baldwin Street and West Armitage Avenue, and the lifting of the through highway status on West Medford Avenue between West Baldwin Street and West Armitage Avenue, the above-captioned parking restriction is no longer needed. This restriction allowed residents to park on this through highway during the winter months of the year where it was previously illegal to do so. This change in the ordinance will keep our records in order, and will not change how residents park on the street at night. Therefore, legislation will be prepared for consideration at the next Public Safety Committee meeting to remove the above-captioned parking restriction.
