

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED Andrea Boivin, who resides at 1545 South 24<sup>th</sup> Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, will pursue a claim against the City of Milwaukee concerning an injury that occurred on May 27, 2006 at approximately 9:10 p.m. at 1543 South 24<sup>th</sup> Street in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

As a direct result of the injury, Andrea Boivin has suffered significant injuries including a fractured right ankle which continues to cause her significant disability.


The City of Milwaukee was negligent in many respects but particularly as it relates to the insufficiency and want of repairs of South 24<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Milwaukee and the City of Milwaukee has had and continues to have the obligation to maintain this street pursuant to §893.83(1), Wis. Stats., and relevant Wisconsin law. Andrea Boivin, while proceeding to unload groceries from the trunk of her car which was parked on the street, stepped off the curb into a hole in the surface of the street which was in poor repair and she tripped fracturing her right ankle.

Andrea Boivin continues to undergo treatment as a result of the injuries which were caused by the conduct of the City of Milwaukee.

This notice is for personal injuries that Andrea Boivin suffered and is served in compliance with Wisconsin law. This is not a claim for damages. We are unable to ascertain the exact amount of damages at this time and a claim for damages will be submitted in the future.
