**Purpose of Amendment:**

The purpose of this amendment is to amend the City's Vendor Service Contract for Doula Services with Joshua Liston Zawadi dba Conscious Community Curators, by increasing the contract total by \$135,000.00 from \$92,000.00 to \$227,000.00. Additionally, extending the contract term for one (1) year from 02/26/2026 through 02/25/2027, exercising the one (1) and only option to extend.
