There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings during normal business hours is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of Kilbourn Avenue and Water Street. You must present a copy of the meeting notice to the parking cashier.

Hello Jose,

My name is [REDACTED]

I'm reaching out regarding several ongoing concerns we've received from [REDACTED] related to Catrina Cantina, located across the street from Taxco.

First, Catrina Cantina currently has two GLP dumpsters located on the Bruce Street sidewalk (please see the attached photos). These dumpsters are frequently left in very poor condition, with glass and garbage scattered throughout the area. [REDACTED] regularly complain that they cannot safely walk through this sidewalk to reach 2nd Street due to the debris. We understand that Catrina Cantina cannot fully control individuals' rummaging through the dumpsters overnight; however, this issue has persisted for quite some time. I have reached out to Catrina Cantina on multiple occasions, but unfortunately the situation has not improved. Addressing this garbage issue would go a long way toward keeping the area clean, safe, and respectable for Walker's Point residents.

Second, [REDACTED] have raised concerns about noise levels in the evenings. Catrina Cafe MKE transitions into Catrina Cantina around 9:00 PM, and we have received multiple complaints regarding loud music after hours and rowdy patrons leaving the establishment. [REDACTED] have contacted the non-emergency line several times, but it appears the music is turned down when officers arrive and then turned back up once they leave.

At this time, we are requesting increased evening patrols around Catrina Cantina, particularly on weekends, as this is when we receive the majority of complaints. We truly enjoy having Catrina Cantina on 5th Street and believe they are a valuable asset to the neighborhood. We are simply hoping to see progress toward resolving these ongoing issues for the benefit of [REDACTED]

Hi Team:

I received a hotspot form from a neighbor expressing concerns in this area. They also sent the attached video. I have asked the neighbor for contact information so we can reach out further, but I wanted to pass along what was sent to me over the weekend.

The neighbor reported the following:

“This is in relation to Catrina Cafe on 5th street. These videos are from a few days after my first report. I believe the 10th.

There has been a fist fight in the street and a man bodily thrown from the bar onto the pavement in addition to the extreme noise and disruption from people screaming (not hyperbole) and revving engines racing up and down the street.

With no stop sign between Virginia and National, they treat the stretch like their own 0 to 60 track.

Timestamps 203am - 247am

- Two fights, one is on video that I sent separate because it was too long, one is kind of on video when zoomed in on the cops on the corner.
- 3-4 sets of cops. Didn't do anything. Literally saw the fight that isn't on video and did not intervene or confront
- cars hit construction cones, kept driving. Not sure how every single person leaving a bar hops in a car. Super hope no one innocent get killed
- per the videos, cars revving engines, people screaming, loud music. Just standing around their cars until nearly 3am
- their security does nothing, walks up and down the block with flashlights pretending they'll confront people but walks by
- people hanging out in the former Fuel Cafe patio, standing in the dark

It started with just Sundays, now it's Friday through Sunday with the occasional weekday night. It's becoming increasingly disruptive and making living in the area undesirable. “

This report/citation is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two, Day Shift, CPU. On Thursday, January 16, 2025, at 1:38 pm, Squad 2166 (P.O. Matthew DIENER and I) assisted Wisconsin Department of Revenue agents (Ashley SCHNERING, tobacco enforcement agents, and tax compliance agents) with a tax warrant and inspection at Snifters, 606 & 610 S 5th St, due to a delinquent tax status. Officers were in full duty uniform and equipped with body worn cameras.

Snifters is licensed to sell food, alcohol and tobacco under licenses held by Keen Hospitality Group LLC. The 2023 application for Snifters lists Julio C MALDONADO (m/w 01/07/78) as the agent of the LLC and owning 60% of Keen Hospitality Group LLC. The application also lists Gabriel LEMUS (10/25/81) as owning 40% of the LLC. The current license for Snifters was granted on 11/21/23 and expires on 1/25/25 with no renewal application on file.

Officers had previously conducted a CPTED inspection of 606 & 610 S 5th St on 12/04/24 and met with a Rosa MARQUEZ (f/w 11/18/75) who is listed as the sole agent of "The Last One LLC" on the application for Catrina's Café (Cigarette & Tobacco, PEP, Class B Tavern, Food Dealer, Sidewalk Dining) filed on 11/19/24 and a pending grant date of 1/21/25 at the time of the inspection. MARQUEZ also holds a valid Bartender's license. At the time of the 12/4/24 inspection, the signage for Snifters had been removed and replaced with signage for Catrina Café.

Officers and DOR agents found the premises to be open with several employees (including MARQUEZ) and subjects eating and drinking at the bar. The signage on the building exterior and on the interior is for Catrina Café. I spoke with MARQUEZ who stated that she runs her business, "Catrina Café", during the morning and afternoon hours, closes her business, and then MALDONADO operates the premises as "Snifters" in the evening and night hours and as a separate business. MARQUEZ stated that she has obtained a Wisconsin Sellers Permit for the location but has yet to be granted her licenses through the City of Milwaukee. When asked about the liquor invoices for Keen Hospitality Group, MARQUEZ stated that she has not purchased any of the alcohol and stated that MALDONADO makes the purchases. MARQUEZ stated that she does sell alcoholic beverages (mimosas and bloody marys) and reimburses MALDONADO for the liquor sales as part of her rent. MARQUEZ stated that she has made tax payments (including for the sale of alcohol) under her sellers permit.

Agents did seize U.S. currency from the registers and gaming machines, tobacco (hooka) products, and 11 bottles of various liquor that did not have invoices reflecting their purchase from a licensed wholesaler.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

The following items pertain to Catrina Café located at 606 & 610 S. 5th Street.

1. On 12/06/25, at 12:40 a.m., Milwaukee Police received a Noise complaint. As the door opened officers observe music emanating out of the building. Attempts were made to contact the caller but were unsuccessful. An employee was advised of the complaint. No other violations were observed.
2. On 12/14/25, at 10:45 p.m., Milwaukee Police received a Noise complaint. Upon officers' arrival the manager was advised of the noise complaint and asked that the music be turned down, which they complied with. (2 Reports)
3. On 12/21/25, at 12:23 a.m., officers were dispatched to a Noise complaint. Upon arrival the front door was observed wide open and music could be heard spilling out of the business. An employee was advised to close the door.
4. On 12/26/25, at 1:58 a.m., officers on patrol observed a large group of subjects from the location engaged in a physical fight. A security guard stated they observed the crowd fighting and deployed pepper spray to disperse the group. An unknown subject removed a long gun from a vehicle and was approaching the group but fled prior to officers' arrival. Security camera footage of the incident was provided.

5. On 12/26/25, at 11:09 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a Noise complaint. Music could be heard when the door opened. The manager was advised of the complaint and informed of steps that could be taken to resolve any noise spillage.
6. On 01/03/26, at 12:28 a.m., Milwaukee Police received a Noise complaint. Upon officers' arrival unreasonable loud music could not be confirmed.

This report is written by P.O. Kevin FREY, assigned to District Two, Late Shift, Squad 2341, with P.O. Jeffrey KIBLER. While on duty, I was riding as passenger in a marked Milwaukee Police Department vehicle (65226) and in full duty uniform equipped with Axon body worn cameras.

On Saturday, December 6th, 2025, I was dispatched to the address of 606 S 5th St (Catrina Cafe), which is located in the City and the County of Milwaukee for a noise nuisance complaint.

Upon arrival, I called the caller, Olivia 847-878-9635, and did not receive an answer. I could not hear any noise coming from the incident address until the front entry door would open.

I then went inside of the business and spoke with the manager Juan J. GONZALEZ (M/W 12-14-1974). I advised GONZALEZ that we were there regarding the noise and that the caller did not pick up the phone. GONZALEZ was cooperative throughout the investigation.

I observed the business to have a valid Class B Tavern License - 0222335 which expires on February 12th, 2026, which was visible and hanging from a wall behind the bar.
