There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 12/07/22 at 10:30a.m., Milwaukee Police held a meeting with the agent of Vieux (1619 S. 1st). This meeting was to discuss the plan of operation and the business relationship between the former licensee/property owner. The agent stated until they are able to book more events, they have had to operate as a traditional tavern. The agent further stated the former licensee/owner of building was observed in the building because they were helping with the sound system. The agent went on to state they were interested in hosting a meeting with neighbors and has full access to video surveillance. They also do not allow patrons to use Scrub A Dub parking lot.
2. On 01/22/23 at 2:49a.m., Milwaukee Police were on patrol in the area of 1619 S. 1st, when they observed an abundance of vehicles in the area, as well as foot traffic. The officers then observed two subjects knock on the front door and were allowed entry. The officers conducted a License Premise Check, and it was determined the subjects were employees. After leaving the tavern officers were approached by subjects regarding a battery. A subject advised the officer a drink was thrown at them and security did nothing. A suspect was ultimately taken into custody for Resist/Obstruct, Battery and Disorderly Conduct.

On Wednesday, December 7, 2022, at 10:30 AM, Captain Patrick PAJOT, Alderman Jose PEREZ, Safe and Sound Neighborhood Coordinator Araceli ARAVELO, and I met with the licensee of "Vieux" (located at 1619 S 1st St), Amelia LOERA-SOLIS, at District Two in order to

discuss the licensee's plan of operation, perception by the neighborhood, and the business relationship between the licensee and the former licensee/property owner, Marcos RAMOS-GARCIA.

LOERA-SOLIS stated that the business was granted its licenses and opened the day before Thanksgiving, November 24, 2022. LOERA-SOLIS stated that because she had not obtained her licenses, she was unable to book events at the premises and has had to operate more as a traditional tavern with "signature nights" until more events are booked. LOERA-SOLIS stated that she has had security present when she has been open.

LOERA-SOLIS stated that the advertising for "The Vieux" that resembled "Points View Boite" was posted by a bartender and it was intended by the bartender to inform her followers that she was serving at a new location. LOERA-SOLIS stated that she has addressed that employee about the posting.

LOERA-SOLIS stated that officers saw RAMOS-GARCIA in the building because he is the property owner and was assisting the D.J. with an issue with the sound system.

LOERA-SOLIS stated that she has reached out to neighbors in order to introduce herself as well as the business but that she has not received much of a response. LOERA-SOLIS stated that she would be willing to host a meeting with the neighbors that would be organized by a third party (Safe & Sound or MPD).

LOERA-SOLIS stated that the business does not use the Scrub-a-Dub parking lot, that she has minimized the frosting on the exterior windows, and now has full access to the video surveillance system.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by Police Officer (P.O.) Quentin C. ARNOLD, assigned to District Two, Late Power Shift, Squad 2467 partnered with P.O Antwan POWELL. Officer POWELL and I were equipped with an AXON body worn camera, which captured this investigation.

On Sunday, January 22nd, 2023, at approximately 2:49 A.M., Squad 2467 Officer POWELL and I (While in full duty Milwaukee Police Uniform with the Milwaukee Police Badge on our outer most garments, operating a marked Milwaukee Police Squad 285 equipped with operating emergency lights and audible siren) were on patrol throughout the area of 200 W. Lapham Street located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

While patrolling past the location of 1619 S. 1st Street which is the tavern named "The Vieux" my partner and I observed a large number of vehicles parked outside the surrounding tavern and lots of foot traffic still in the surrounding area. I then observed a vehicle park in the front of the tavern and two individuals knock on the front door and get let into the tavern.

My partner and I conducted a tavern check regarding. Upon arrival to the front of the establishment the front door was locked, but it was after hours and no longer operating. Security opened the door and once inside I spoke to the manager I identified by a WI Driver's License Identification Card as RODRIGUEZ, JUAN FRANCISCO.

I asked RODRIGUEZ about the subjects entering late, RODRIGUEZ stated that both subjects work security for him at a different tavern he manages. RODRIGUEZ stated that the two subjects also work at The Vieux.

RODRIGUEZ was cooperative and all licenses were posted within public view. RODRIGUEZ also stated that they have nine working cameras throughout the tavern.

Upon leaving the tavern my partner and I were confronted with an ongoing battery complaint. The complainant stated that the suspect was throwing drinks within the tavern and that security didn't do anything. It should be noted that subjects involved were parked in a private parking lot no longer in use by The Vieux. Ultimately the suspect was taken into custody regarding resist obstruct, battery, and disorderly conduct and issued citations regarding.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


