

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In the Matter of Vacation of a part of unnamed street lying between S. Water Street and the Milwaukee River in the 5th Ward.

No. 49730 B.

June 11, 1932 Petition of Milwaukee Western Malt Co., by President and Secretary, Corporate Seal, owner of Lots 8 and 9 in Block 64 and Lots 1 and 2 in Block 65 in Subdivision of Lots 3 and 5 in the North West 1/4 of Section 33-6-22, filed, representing that the petitioners are the owners of all of the property in the 5th Ward of said City which abuts upon the portion of the unnamed street between South Water Street and the Milwaukee River which is proposed to be vacated, each owning the property immediately following his signature to this petition hereinafter subscribed.

That the petitioners are of the opinion that the public interest requires a vacation of that portion of the unnamed street as shown on the map and description hereto annexed, and they are further of the opinion that the aforesaid portion of the unnamed street between South Water Street and the Milwaukee River is no longer of any public utility.

That the land proposed to be vacated and the location and situation of the proposed portion of the unnamed street to be vacated as aforesaid is more particularly shown in the annexed map, the same being colored red on said map to distinguish it from property surrounding and adjacent thereto, which said map is hereto annexed and

made a part of this petition.

WHEREFORE, petitioners pray that the piece and parcel of land described as aforesaid may be vacated according to law for the reason that the same is no longer of public utility, and that it will be for the public interest to have the same vacated.

Annexed to said petition is a plat of survey of the proposed parcel of land to be vacated and also a more particular description of the property as follows:

Commencing at a point in the most Westerly corner of Lot1; Block 65 in the Subdivision of Lots 3 and 5 in the North West 1/4 of Section 33-7-22, said point also lying in the North Easterly line of South Water Street; running thence North Westerly along the North Easterly line of South Water Street extended 5 feet to a point; thence North Easterly along a line parallel to and 5 feet North Westerly measured at right angles from the North Westerly line of Lot 1 aforesaid 199.21 feet to a point in the South Westerly line of the Milwaukee River; thence South Easterly along the South Westerly line of the Milwaukee River 5 feet more or less to a point in the most Northerly corner of said Lot 1; thence South Westerly along the North Westerly line of Lot 1 aforesaid 200 feet to the point of commencement.

June 13, 1932 Resolution presented reciting the fact of the presentation of the foregoing petition to the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, and wherein it is,

RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that said petition be and the same hereby is granted

and that the following described portion of street, to-wit:

Commencing at a point in the most Westerly corner of Lot 1, Block 65, in the Subdivision of Lots 3 and 5 in the North West 1/4 of Section 33-7-22, said point also lying in the North Easterly line of South Water Street; running thence North Westerly along the North Easterly line of South Water Street extended 5 feet to a point; thence North Easterly along a line parallel to and 5 feet North Westerly measured at right angles from the North Westerly line of Lot 1 aforesaid 199.21 feet to a point in the South Westerly line of the Milwaukee River: thence South Easterly along the South Westerly line of the Milwaukee River 5 feet more or less to a point in the most Northerly corner of said Lot 1: thence South Westerly along the North Westerly line of Lot 1 aforesaid 200 feet to the point of commencement, be and same hereby is vacated for the reason that the same is of no public utility and the public interest requires the same to be vacated.

Petition and resolution referred to committee on streets - alleys - sewers - and the board of public land commissioners.

Endorsed on said resolution are the reports of the committees on streets - alleys - sewers - and the board of public land commissioners, recommending the granting of said petition and the adoption of said resolution, which said resolution was countersigned by the City Comptroller on July 11, 1932, adopted by the Common Council on July 11, 1932, by a vote of 27 to 0, and approved by the Mayor on July 12, 1932.

July 25, 1932 Resolution presented reciting the proceedings heretofore had herein and wherein it is,

RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Commissioner of Public Works be and he
hereby is directed, within one month from the date of the
adoption of this resolution, to view the aforesaid portion
of street vacated and assess the benefits and damages
accruing and arising from said vacation and to make his
report of his assessment of such benefits and damages to
the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, as required
by law.

Referred to the Committee on streets - alleys- sewers.

Endorsed on said resolution is the report of the Committee on streets - alleys and sewers recommending the adoption of said resolution, which said resolution was countersigned by the City Comptroller on September 6, 1932.

Adopted by the Common Council on the same day by vote of 26 to 0, and approved by the Mayor on September 7, 1932.

October 31, 1932 Communication received by the Commissioner of Public Works to which is appended the assessment of benefits and damages in the above entitled matter, which said communication and assessment were referred to the committee on streets - alleys - sewers on the same day, which reported thereon in the form of a resolution annexed thereto and made a part thereof, wherein it is,

RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the assessment of benefits and damages in the
matter of the vacation of part of unnamed street lying
between South Water Street and the Milwaukee River in the
5th Ward of the City of Milwaukee, as made, reviewed,
corrected and completed by the Commissioner of Public Works,

of the City of Milwaukee, and all proceedings had in relation thereto be and the same hereby are confirmed and the proper city officers be and hereby are directed to make proper entries thereof on the tax roll for the year 1932.

Signed by the individual members of said committee, adopted by the Common Council on November 14, 1932 by a vote of 26 to 0 and countersigned by the City Comptroller on November 14, 1932.

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A certified copy of the RESOLUTION in the Matter of the vacation of part of unnamed street lying between S. Water St. and the Milwaukee River, in the 5th Ward of the City of Milwaukee was recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Milwaukee County on November 25, 1932 in Volume 1377 of Deeds, on page 390, as Document No. 1925041.
