Progress of the goals of the organization regarding the sister city relationship:

Our commitment to serve as the official sponsor between the city of Milwaukee and the city of Irpin remains steadfast. Together, we aim to facilitate a rich intercultural exchange between these two cities while also directing our efforts towards the critical task of reconstruction and providing relief to the war-torn city of Irpin.

Progress of activities of the organization in relation to the sister city:

As a sponsoring agency dedicated to fostering sister city relationships, our efforts have focused on strengthening ties between communities and providing vital support where it's needed the most:

Humanitarian Support: Friends of Be an Angel hosted Ukrainian families with children diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) in Milwaukee, providing a lifeline for medical treatment not available in Ukraine.

Commitment to Sister City Committee Meetings: We remained actively engaged by participating in all Sister City Committee Meetings, contributing to ongoing collaboration and coordination efforts.
